ARCHAIC POTTERY MASKS AND HEADS.

These masks were found in a mound at Miraflores, about 1½ miles from the City of Guatemala (Central America).

The mounds are on the surface of an Ancient city, discovered a year ago, 1927, on the occasion of heavy earth-slides during heavy rains.

The city is supposed to have been sunk by prehistoric earthquakes centuries ago. The earth is of a cavernous nature; excavations would reveal a city of old relics, but the Government has prohibited relics leaving this district.
