



Annual Report, Year 1925-26.

COTTAGE HOSPITAL.

IN presenting their report for the past year, the Committee sincerely thank not only their old and tried friends, who for many years have so regularly contributed to the welfare of the Hospital, but also the general public for the renewed interest and enthusiasm they have shown in the work. The growth of this new spirit and the willingness of all classes to help, as shown by the excellent response to the efforts of the Hospital Collection Committee, are very gratifying and encouraging to the Committee.

The work of extending and improving the Operating Theatre has just been completed and we now possess a modern and well equipped Theatre. Owing to the delay in completing these alterations occasioned by industrial troubles, and the resultant difficulty in obtaining the necessary materials, surgical work was entirely suspended for a period of about five months. In the face of these adverse conditions the drop in the number of admissions and operations (from 135 and 99 in 1925 to 106 and 68 respectively during the present year) may therefore be considered to be relatively small, and the Committee confidently expect that the Hospital—which in the space of two short years has been equipped with electric light, what is practically a new Operating Theatre and a wireless receiving set—will in the future gain increasing recognition and so be enabled to administer to a still greater extent to the requirements of the district. X

Miss MacGreggor resigned her post as Matron in October, 1925, to take up another appointment, and Miss Catherine Surtees-Wilson was appointed to succeed her. Miss Wilson has earned the gratitude of the Committee by her unremitting devotion to duty and the welfare of her patients, and they tender her their sincere thanks.

The Committee also wish to thank all those who in any way contributed to the success of the "West Cumberland Times" Wireless Fund, and so made possible the installation of a wireless receiving set to while away the tedious hours of sickness and convalescence.

With reference to the accounts we have again to record the great success of the second House-to-House Collection the amount raised being £377-4-6. Income from other sources having kept fairly steady, we are able to report a very satisfactory total of £1358 for the year, as against £1429 last year. A small balance of £33-4-7 remaining out of the funds provided for the Electric Light Installation, has been transferred to the ordinary account, and brings the total credits up to £1391.

The total ordinary expenditure is £1215 as compared with £1281 last year, the main item being a reduction of £80 in Provisions, which follows a similar reduction last year of £83. It may be pointed out, however, that there have been fewer patients, the number of hospital days being 2317 as against 2927. The cost per patient for provisions remains the same £3, and the daily cost for provisions for all in residence, patients and staff, works out at 1/5 per head against 1/4 last year. There has been also a reduction of £20 in "Fuel and Lighting." This is interesting as the item includes the cost of electric lighting in place of gas.

The number of beds occupied works out at 6.3, as against 8 last year, the duration of stay being about the same 21.8 days. The total cost per patient was £11-9-3, being at the rate of £3-14-2 per week, and the total cost per occupied bed was £192-17-1.

The net result of the year's working, from the financial point of view, has been satisfactory, the debit balance having been reduced from £191 to £14.

No payment was made during the year in respect of the enlargement of the Operating Theatre, which has since been completed. This will be dealt with in next year's accounts.

Of the total income £860 has been provided by voluntary effort, and the grateful thanks of the Committee are due to all who have helped to achieve this splendid result.
