

# Report.

URING the year 1921 nine patients have been treated in the Homes of St. Giles, and others outside have been assisted. At the moment our accommodation is insufficient, and we are unable to receive any of the fresh cases which are constantly being brought to our notice. The circumstances in which sufferers from leprosy find themselves are so exceptionally distressing that we are most reluctant to refuse them admission. The erection of a third bungalow for the reception of two or three more cases has long been contemplated, and it was hoped that the time had now come when this block might be put in hand. Great efforts have, therefore, been made during the past year to make the needs and work of St. Giles Homes better known to the public. A Council has been formed with this special purpose in view, the President of which is our Patron, H.R.H. Princess Christian, and its Chairman, Earl Buxton. On 10th November a Drawing-room Meeting was held, by the kindness of Lady St. Helier, at 52, Portland Place, at which the Princess took the chair, and Earl Buxton, Sir Malcolm Morris, Dr. MacLeod and Sister Clare also spoke. The Directors wish to take this opportunity of recording their gratitude to Her Royal Highness for graciously presiding on this occasion.

On 28th October *The Times* printed a long account, by its Medical Correspondent, of the Homes of St. Giles, together with a leading article calling attention to the needs of the Homes;

and on 5th November appeared a letter from Sir Malcolm Morris, thanking *The Times* for these articles, and reiterating his Appeal for an endowment fund. The Directors take the opportunity of thanking the Proprietors of *The Times* for their support of this important charity.

In October two performances of "Hamlet" were given by Miss Mona Maughan and her Company. The Directors are very much indebted to Miss Maughan and her Company for their generosity in giving these performances, which were financially successful. They are also indebted to the Hon. Mrs. Henn Collins, one of our Council, for her help in organising them.


The practical outcome of these various activities was that a sum of about £1,000 was raised; but, seeing that the annual expenditure on the Homes amounts to nearly £1,500, this result cannot be looked upon as very satisfactory, or as contributing anything in the way of endowment. The question of building was, therefore, of necessity again postponed. On the other hand, the Company of St. Giles will shortly benefit to the extent of £500 by a legacy from Miss Land, who had generously contributed on several occasions during her life.

The Directors announce with great pleasure that Her Most Gracious Majesty the Queen was graciously pleased to contribute a further donation of £10, and that Her Majesty Queen Alexandra has graciously contributed £20. His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales has also graciously contributed the sum of £10. They also desire to express their thanks to the Trustees of the Strathcona Bequest for a grant of £375; to the Trustees of the Sherburn Hospital, Durham, for one of £200; to the Trustees of Ripon Hospital for one of £25; and to the British Red Cross Society for a donation, generously renewed, of £300.

A three-quarter size billiard table, a congregational thankoffering to one of the Fathers of the S.D.C., is an unfailing source of amusement and serves to while away many an otherwise weary hour. Two theatrical entertainments by the Patients took place at Christmas time in the Army Hut which is now used as a recreation room.

The Directors are happy to report that Sir James Du Boulay has consented to join the Board. As the brother of Sister Clare, the Sister-in-Charge, he is particularly welcome.

In accordance with the Articles of Association, Sir Malcolm Morris and Mr. H. L. D. Engleheart retire from office, but being eligible offer themselves for re-election.
