EXPLANATORY NOTE.

- 1. The present edition of this list contains information relating to Special Schools, Institutions for the training of Blind and other Defective Students, and Nursery Schools recognised by the Board of Education under their Special Services Regulations, 1925—Grant Regulations No. 19. In addition it contains information relating to certain Technical Classes for Defective Students.
- 2. Part I of the list includes all Schools certified by the Board under Part V of the Education Act, 1921, for the education of blind, deaf, mentally defective, physically defective, and epileptic children. All the Schools are shown grouped under geographical areas in alphabetical order (separately for England and Wales with Monmouthshire), the general type of case for which the school makes provision being indicated by the entry in the appropriate column of a figure representing the accommodation of the School. The figures are shown in heavy type for residential and in italics for day accommodation. The addresses of residential Schools are given in every case in which the official name of the School does not sufficiently indicate the locality in which it is situated. Particulars of Schools maintained by a Local Education Authority in the area of another Authority are entered under the area of the latter Authority with a footnote indicating the maintaining Authority. The names of these Schools also appear under the area of the Authority providing them.

In the case of Residential Schools for mentally defective and epileptic children, and of Schools for physically defective children, the fact that a School is recognised by another Government Department is indicated in a separate column. In this column the letters "H.O." mean that the School is recognised by the Home Office as an Industrial School; the letters "B. of C." mean that the School is recognised by the Board of Control under the Mental Deficiency Acts, 1913–1927, and the letters "M. of H." mean that the School is recognised by the Ministry of Health for the treatment of tuberculosis.

- 3. The Schools for physically defective children are classified by the entry of different letters in the column dealing with those Schools with a view to indicating the particular type or types of case for which each School provides. The various types of School are classified as follows:—
 - C = Schools for Cripples, i.e., for the education of children suffering from crippling defects for which no specific treatment is provided.

- C1 = Hospital Schools for the education and treatment of children suffering from crippling defects due to nonpulmonary tuberculosis and other causes.
- C2 = Schools for the education and general care of children subsequent to the surgical treatment of crippling defects.
- D = Open-air Schools for the education of delicate and debilitated children.
- H = Schools for children suffering from heart disease.
- P = Sanatorium Schools for the education and medical treatment of children suffering from pulmonary tuberculosis.

It is clear, however, that inasmuch as many Certified Schools admit children suffering from a variety of types of physical defect, no system of classification can be watertight. Some Schools will therefore be found to have more than one letter attached.

4. Part II of the list contains particulars of Institutions, Schools, and Classes, recognised by the Board as providing higher education for blind, deaf, defective, and epileptic students, and is divided into three sections.

In Section I the Institutions recognised under Chapter VII of the Special Services Regulations, 1925, are shown grouped under geographical areas in alphabetical order (separately for England and Wales with Monmouthshire), the type of case for which the Institution makes provision being indicated in the appropriate column by a figure representing the accommodation of the Institution.

In Section II the Technical Classes for defective students are shown in a similar order, the type of case for which the class provides being indicated in a separate column.

In Section III are given the Institutions providing secondary education for blind children.

- 5. Part III contains a list of Nursery Schools recognised by the Board, with the accommodation.
 - 6. The following abbreviations are used :-
 - Cl. = Council, indicating that the School is maintained by a Council (or a Joint Committee of Councils) acting as Local Education Authority.
 - Cl.(T) indicates that the Institution is maintained by a Council (or a Joint Committee of Councils) acting as Tuberculosis Authority.
 - B. = Boys. G. = Girls. M. = Mixed (both sexes). Sr. B. = Senior Boys. Sr. G. = Senior Girls. Sr. M. = Senior Mixed. Jr. M. = Junior Mixed. Inf. = Infants.
