1. FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE:

The following Order made by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries on 11th January, 1933, is published for the information and attention of the Force. -

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.
(DATED 11TH JANUARY, 1933).

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (REGULATION OF MOVEMENT) ORDER OF 1933.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

Restrictions on Movement and Markets of Animals in the Controlled Area.

Movement out of the Controlled Area.

1. No animal shall be moved out of the Area described in the First Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the Controlled Area) except into any Infected Area contiguous thereto and then only if accompanied by, and subject to the conditions of, the licence required under the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

Movement into the Controlled Area.

2. No animal shall be moved into the Controlled Area except direct to a farm or slaughterhouse, and then only if accompanied by a licence granted by an Inspector of the local Authority under this Order, and subject to the detention of the animal on the farm premises for 14 days or the slaughter of the animal in the slaughterhouse, as the case may be, in accordance with the conditions of the licence.

Provided that this Article shall not be deemed to authorise the grant of a licence for the movement of any animal into the Controlled Area from any Infected Area.

Movement within the Controlled Area.

3. No animal shall be moved by road, railway or water within the Controlled Area except with a licence which may be granted by an inspector of the local authority under this Order if in his opinion the movement is necessary, and subject to the conditions applicable to the licence; Provided that no licence shall be granted for the movement of any animal from any premises on which a licensed market or sale of fat animals is held otherwise than direct to a slaughterhouse or back to the premises from which they were taken to the licensed market or sale for detention thereon for a period of six days.

ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR OF VETERINARY AND HYGIENE

NOTICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF VETERINARY AND HYGIENE

The Director of Veterinary and Hygiene has received from
an exporter of the above named animal a licence for the
exportation of the same, and it is hereby notified that
the same is hereby granted.

Restrictions on export and the date of issue of the licence

Movement out of the controlled zone

1. No animal shall be moved out of the zone described in the
First Schedule to the Order, or to any other zone, unless
it is accompanied by a licence issued by the Director of
Veterinary and Hygiene.

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2. To animal shall be issued a licence for the exportation
of the same, and it is hereby notified that the same is
hereby granted.

3. The licence shall be issued on the condition that the
animal shall be returned to the zone of issue of the licence
within the period of six months from the date of issue of
the licence.

Movement within the controlled zone

4. To animal shall be moved by road, railway or water within
the controlled zone except with a licence which shall be granted
by the Director of Veterinary and Hygiene, and subject to the
conditions of the licence, provided that the licence shall
be granted only on the condition that the animal is not to
be moved out of the zone of issue of the licence, and that
the animal shall be returned to the zone of issue of the licence
within the period of six months from the date of issue of
the licence.



Markets and Sales in the Controlled Area.

4. - (1) No market, fair, sale or exhibition of animals shall be held on any premises in the Controlled Area except in accordance with this article.

(2) (a) A market or sale of animals intended for immediate slaughter may be held in any market, fairground, or saleyard if a licence to hold such market or sale is obtained from the local authority. Any movement of an animal from such market or sale shall be subject to the provisions of Article 3 of this order.

(b) A sale of animals may be held on farm premises if a licence to hold such sale is obtained from the local authority. The movement of animals from such sale shall be subject to the provisions of Article 3 of this Order.

(3) A veterinary inspector of the local authority shall attend and examine the animals exposed at every market or sale licensed under this article.

Forms and Conditions of Movement Licences.

5. - (1) Licences for the movement of animals granted under this Order shall be in the form and subject to the conditions set forth in the Second Schedule to this Order and may be granted only by an inspector of the local authority of the district in which the place of destination is situate.

(2) No licence shall be available for the movement of the animals unless and until it is countersigned by an inspector of the local authority of the district in which the premises from which the animals are to be moved are situate.

Movement of Animals through the Controlled Area by Railway without untrucking permitted.

6. This Order shall not prevent the movement of animals direct by railway through the Controlled Area from a place outside the Controlled Area to another place outside the Controlled Area.

Disposal of Slaughterhouse Manure and Refuse.

7. No manure or waste meat trimmings or any other refuse shall be moved from any slaughterhouse in the Controlled Area unless permission for such movement is given in writing by an inspector of the local authority of the place of destination. Any person removing or receiving any such material and the occupier of any premises to which it is moved shall take all practicable steps to secure that it is not fed to or brought into contact with animals. Notwithstanding the definition of the term "slaughterhouse" contained in Article 11 of this Order, the term "slaughterhouse" for the particular purposes of this Article shall include any slaughterhouse which forms part of a farm or other premises.

Saving for Orders and Regulations.

8. No licence under this Order shall authorise the movement of animals in contravention of any regulations made by a local authority other than the local authority by whose inspector the licence was issued, or authorise the movement of animals in contravention of any other Order of the Minister for the time being in force.

Section 2. License for the Control of Disease

4. (1) No person shall sell or exhibit or transport or carry or convey or transport or carry or convey any animal in violation of the provisions of this section.

Section 6. License for the Control of Disease

Production of Licences - Names and Addresses.

9. The person in charge of any animal being moved, where under this Order a licence is necessary, shall on demand made under this Order by an inspector of the Ministry or of a local authority or by a police constable, produce the licence, and allow a copy of or extract from it to be taken, and shall also if required give his name and address.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

10. This Order shall, except where otherwise expressly provided be executed and enforced by the local authority.

Meaning of Terms.

11. In this Order :-

"Animals" means cattle, sheep, goats, pigs or deer.

"Slaughterhouse" means premises used habitually and solely for the purpose of slaughtering animals, but does not include (1) a slaughterhouse which forms part of a farm, or (2) any premises on which animals other than those intended for immediate slaughter are kept.

Offences.

12. Any person committing or aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the commission of any breach of the provisions of this Order or the conditions of any licence granted thereunder is liable, on summary conviction, to the penalties provided by the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927.

Commencement.

13. This Order shall come into immediate operation.

Short Title.

14. This Order may be cited as the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933.

Production of Licenses - Terms and Conditions

9. The person applying for an animal license under this Order shall, in addition to the fee thereon, pay to the Department of Agriculture a fee of \$1.00 for the production of a license. The fee for the production of a license shall be paid in advance and shall not be refunded if the license is not issued.

Production of License - Terms and Conditions

10. This Order shall apply to all animals which are produced or imported and exported by the local authority.

Production of License

11. In this Order -

"animal" means cattle, sheep, goats, pigs or deer.

"diseases" means any disease which is communicable to man or which is a disease of man or which is a disease of any other animal other than those specified in the Schedule of Diseases of Animals, 1947.

12. Any person who is guilty of an offence under this Order or who is guilty of an offence under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1947, shall be liable to the penalties provided in the Schedule of Penalties to the Diseases of Animals Act, 1947.

13. This Order shall come into operation on the date specified in the Schedule of Dates of Commencement of Operation.

Short Title

14. This Order may be cited as the Animal License Act, 1947.
