ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 12TH JANUARY, 1933).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows :-

Movement of imported animals into Controlled Area.

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 2 of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933, imported animals landed at an approved landing place in accordance with the provisions of the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man) Order of 1923 or the Importation of Canadian Cattle Order of 1923 or any Orders amending or superseding the said Orders of 1923 may be moved from the landing place to a destination within the Controlled Area provided that such animals are accompanied throughout the movement by : -

- (a) A licence issued under and in accordance with the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933 by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the place of destination; and
- (b) The licence granted by the Inspector of the Ministry authorising the movement of the animals from the landing place, which will not be issued until the licence of the Local Authority's Inspector is produced to the Inspector of the Ministry at the landing place.

2. This Order shall be read as one with the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933 and shall take immediate effect.
