ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(Dated 17th January, 1933).

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (REGULATION OF MOVEMENT) ORDER
OF 1933. (No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

Contraction of the Controlled Area.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933, shall be read and have effect as if the following counties, viz., Essex, Suffolk, Norfolk, Cambridge, Isle of Ely, Huntingdon and Soke of Peterborough (including any county or other Boroughs geographically situated therein) were excluded from the Area described in the First Schedule to the said Order.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall be read as one with the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933, and shall come into operation on the nineteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-three.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933 (No.2).
