ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 19TH JANUARY, 1933).

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (REGULATION OF MOVEMENT) ORDER OF 1933 (No.3).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

Contraction of the Controlled Area.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933 as amended by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933 (No.2), shall be read and have effect as if the following counties, viz., Lincoln, (Parts of Lindsey, Kesteven and Holland), Nottingham, Derby, Stafford, Leicester, Rutland, Northampton, Bedford, Warwick, Worcester, Gloucester, Somerset and Dorset (including any county or other boroughs geographically situated therein) were excluded from the Area described in the First Schedule to the first named Order.

Saving for Existing Orders.

2. Nothing in this Order shall effect the operation of any Order declaring an Area to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the Twenty-third day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-three.

Short Title.

4. This Order shall be read as one with the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933 and may be cited as the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1933 (No.3).

Whereas the following further Order was made by the
Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries on 19th January 1933
in respect of the prevention and control of the spread

of the disease known as
Foot-and-mouth disease (hereinafter referred to as "the disease")
and in pursuance of the powers vested in him in that behalf
by the said Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries is hereby
authorized to do all such things as may be necessary or expedient
for the purposes of the said Act, and in particular to make
such regulations as he may think fit for the purposes of the said Act.

2. The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries is hereby
authorized to do all such things as may be necessary or expedient
for the purposes of the said Act, and in particular to make
such regulations as he may think fit for the purposes of the said Act.

Regulations for the Prevention of the Spread of the Disease

3. In pursuance of the powers conferred on the Minister of
Agriculture and Fisheries by the said Act, the following
regulations are hereby made:

Regulation 1

1. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-
third day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-three.

Regulation 2

2. This Order shall be subject to the provisions of the said Act
and to the provisions of any Order in Council made thereunder.
