These corrections I enclose on a separate sheet.

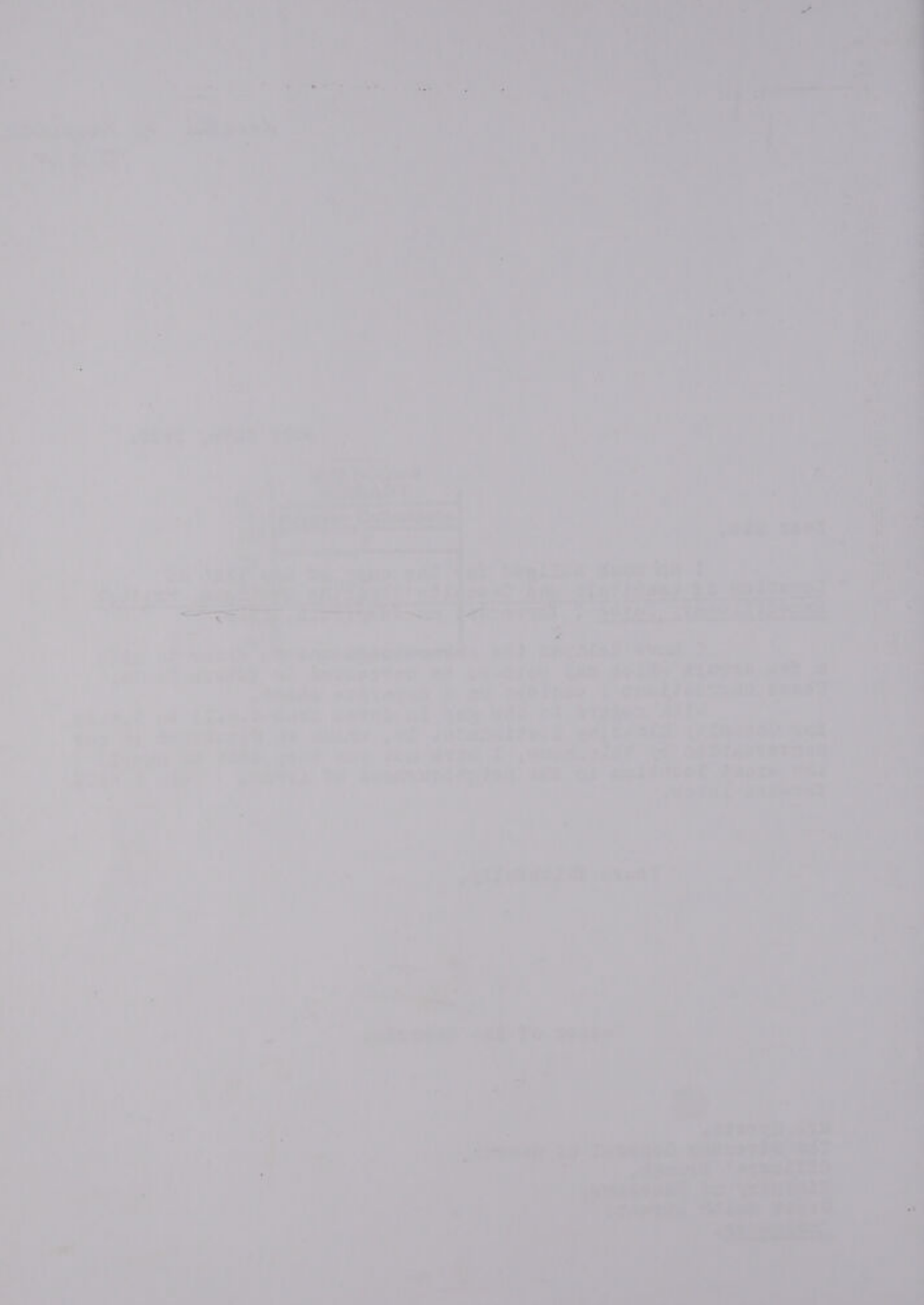
With regard to the gap in dates from 4.8.17 to 9.4.18,

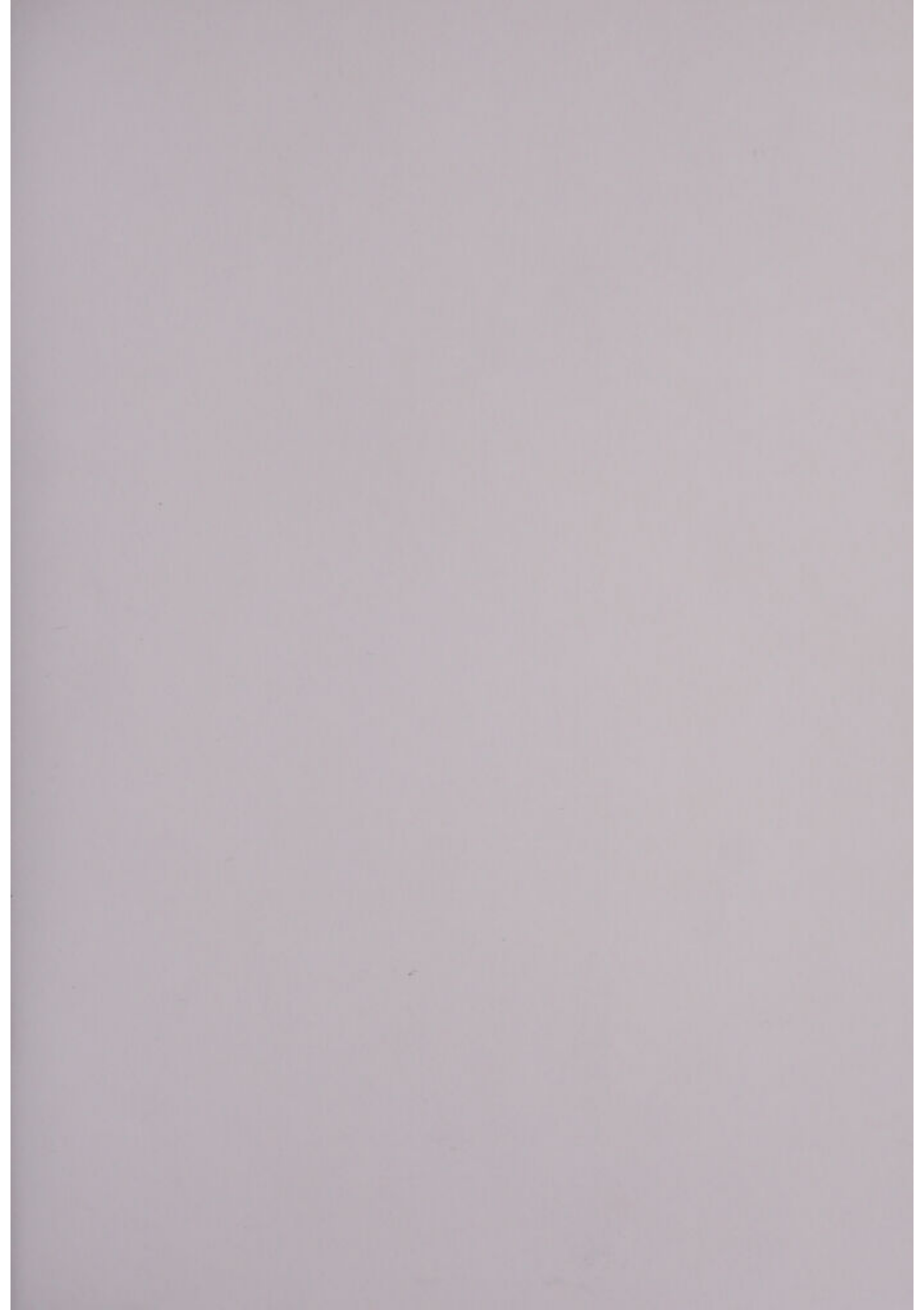

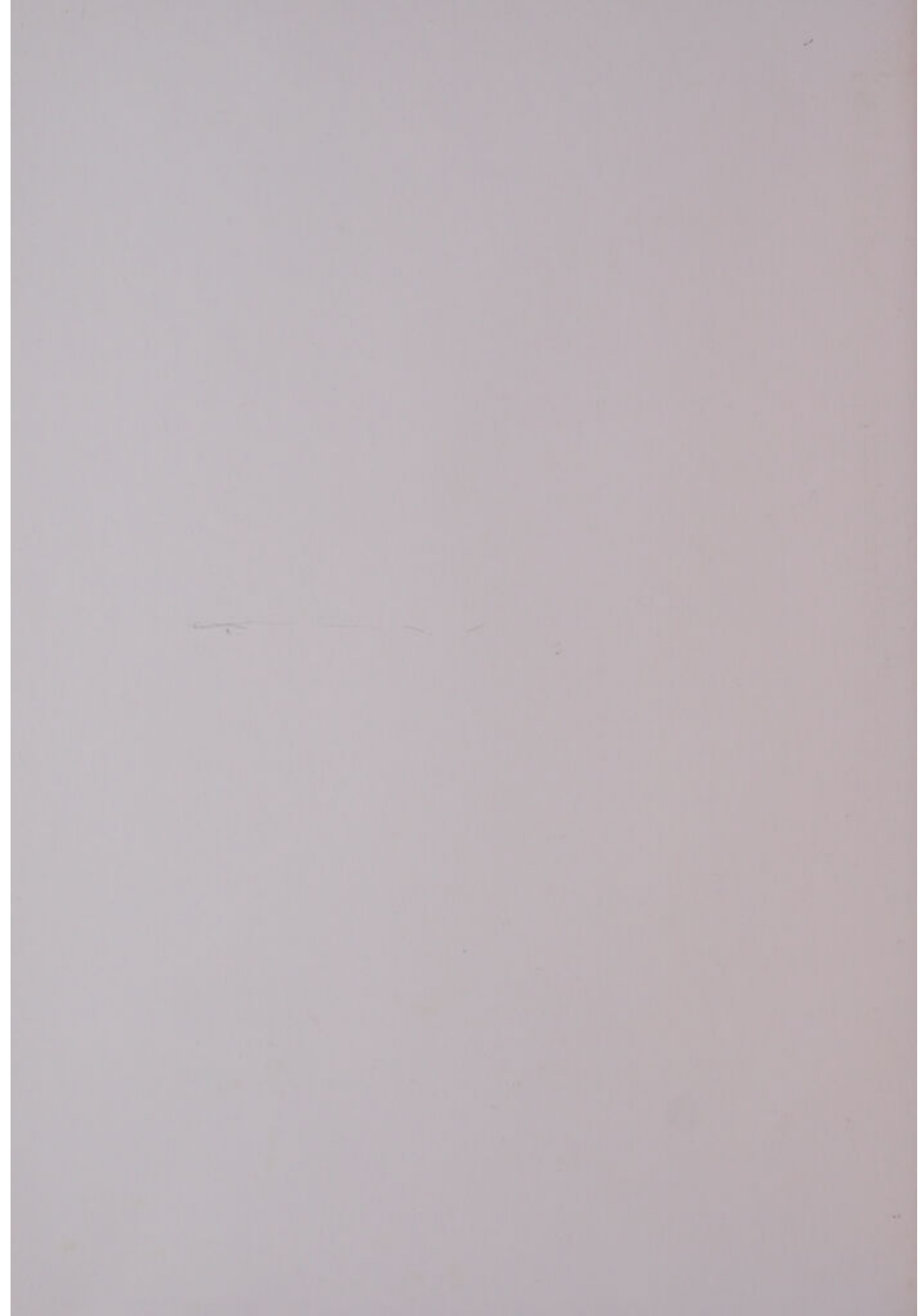
