**Victoria** By the Grace of **God** of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland Queen,  
Defender of the Faith, To all and sundry to whom these Presents shall come or may appertain, Greeting,

Whereas We taking into Our Royal Consideration that the Office of Regius Professor of Surgery in Our University of Glasgow is now vacant by the death of Doctor James Adair Laurie, and being well informed of the Ability and good endowments of Joseph Lister, Esquire for discharging the Trusts thereof, Have nominated and presented like as We by these Presents nominate and present the said Joseph Lister to be Regius Professor of Surgery in the said University of Glasgow during all the days of his lifetime, Giving, Granting, and disposing to him during the time aforesaid, the whole Fees, Casualties, Pensions, Profits, Emoluments, Privileges and Immunities whatsoever due and belonging to the said Office or Profession, or that shall hereafter pertain or belong thereto, with full power to the said Joseph Lister to uplift and receive the Fees or Salaries settled upon the said Office or Profession, such Salary or Salaries to commence from the decease of the said Doctor James Adair Laurie, and to use exercise and discharge the said Power and Privileges competent and pertaining thereto, as fully and freely in all respects and conditions as the said Doctor James Adair Laurie, or any other Professor of Surgery in Our said University of Glasgow hath done or ought to have done at any time heretofore, Requiring thereby the Rector, Principal Dean, and other Professors and Masters in the said University to admit enter and receive the said Joseph Lister to the said Office and Place in the usual manner that Professors of Surgery have been received and admitted there, Given at Our Court at Saint James's and under Our Privy Seal of Scotland at Edinburgh the Twenty eight day of January Eighteen hundred and sixty, In the Twenty third year of Our Reign. — Per Signaturam.
