Spent some time piece of
rope to furnish leaves. then I
did 4 boxes March lunch
1 cork. Box Choc. Please you
biscuits 2 spoon jam each
very good. 1st lunch. then
2 1/2 boxes on arch camp
for night. 1 cork and in
35 min. Carried 6 pan 1. I
WAB Rr burnt for horse

Baked pie in muddy and small
choc. Cocoa. then we had jam
to finish up so were really
full for once. It is settled for
our further South to be on 25th
then we go into the land. Michael
saw the sled Capt. I to
be inclined to Scurvy so we
will not be going on further
as we are so far from our base
we hope to cross 82 or in 2
days any day. What a Christmas
baking hot. It must have been
so different at home.

Boxing Day. Similar weather
but only similar. B's high eye
so bad that we camped for
day. Poor boy suffered agonies
all afternoon in spite of glimproy.
