much ad my boord tuning and expert to keepe and exercysse the offyce, busynesse and function of a
doe admitt and Midwifesse in and through the Diocessis of London and Norwich aforesaid of
giving you report to our province of Canterbury, with the best diligentie you may or can, in thid
said office bithalfe indifferently both to poor and riche And also to performe & accomplish
and function of all things about the same according to your oath therupon made and given upon
a Midwifesse. The Holy Evangelist ad farr as God will gide you arrant and inable you. We
intend to settis of wee have gaured our seale of. Ress. to be putt hereto
written the xxviii day of January in the year of our Lord
God (according to the Concepotion of the Chaste of England) one thousand
ye hundred, twenty and nyne and in the xvijth year of our translation.
