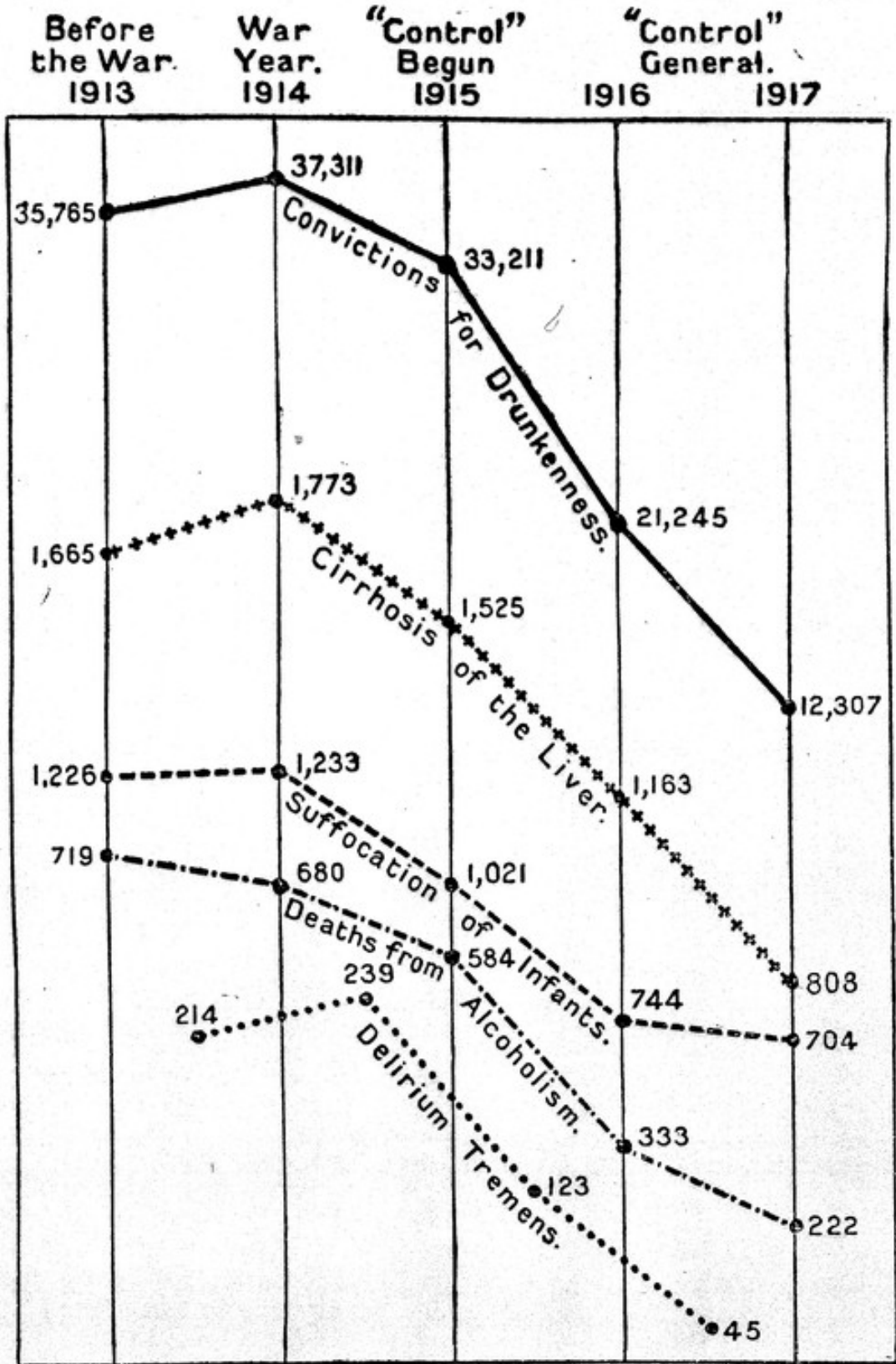

CHART SHOWING THE UNITY OF DOWNWARD MOVEMENT DURING 1915-17 IN THE CURVES OF :—

- (1) Convictions for Drunkenness ;
- (2) Deaths from Cirrhosis of the Liver ;
- (3) Deaths of Infants from Suffocation (both sexes) ;
- (4) Deaths from Alcoholism ;
- (5) Cases of Delirium Tremens treated in certain Poor Law Infirmaries.
