 Rare. - Proksch II, p.4. - One of the earliest works con-
 taining anatomical engravings printed in colours. The coloured
 plate represents three different reproductions of the male ge-
 nital. - Copies with the coloured plate are very scarce !!

2. Deusing, A. Exercitationes de motu animalium, ubi de motu mus-
 culorum et respiratione...de sensuum functionibus, de appetitu
 sensitivo et affectibus. 8 leaves, 319 pp. 16mo. Half vellum.
 Groeningen, 1661. Swiss Frs. 32.-

Deusing was one of the very first adherents to Harvey's discov-
ery. The above work is principally based on Harvey's theories.
First edition!

First edition !

 usual size of obl. folio(measuring 310 x 110 millim.). Half
 vellum. Italy, end of the 17th century. Swiss Frs. 95.-

This "Ricettario" contains about 200 different recipes of
 pharmaceutical and alchemical interest. At the end a detail-
 ed, alphabetical index. We only mention: "Sal di absintio;
 oglio contro mallefficio; cerotto mercuriale, decotto carminativo;
 sublimato dolce, pomata per le mani; etc. etc. - A great part
 of the receipts deals with cosmetics. The manuscript is in good
 condition.

Santorius founded the physiology of metabolism through his experiments and data upon what he called the "insensible perspiration" of the body.

Uncommon Italian work on surgery and dentistry. Augmented by
Fioravanti's well-known surgical treatise. - A few stains.

Deals especially with Caesarean section and abortion.

Choulant-Frank, p. 315. Important as being the first anatomical work by Mascagni, written in response to a price question announced by the Academy of Sciences of Paris.

Contains quite a number of original observations concerning blood-corpuscles, arteries, etc.

Good edition of one of the chief works of this important medical teacher. - Contains the following chapters on dentistry: "Della chirurgia delle gengive, della chirurgia dei denti, dei denti stretti insieme, degli instrumenti a cavare i denti". - Margins of three leaves strengthened, a few stains. Good copy.

Proksch I, 34. Deals also mainly with small pox.

Chouiant p. 63. - The rare second Greek edition of Nicander, preceeded only by the extremely rare edition of Aldus in 1523. The classic work on toxicology. - One leaf browned. Good copy.
14. Colombo, Realdo. De re anatomica libri XV. 4 leaves, 495 pp. Old limp vellum. Paris, 1562. Swiss Frs. 145.-
Colombo was assistent to Vesalius, and is mentioned by him with generosity. The attention that Colombo gives to the movements of the heart and lungs is important as showing the interest in these subjects at the Padovan School forty years before Harvey came there. Colombo demonstrated experimentally that the blood passes from the lung into the pulmonary vein. - A few stains.

The "Edition de la Faculté de médecine de Paris", entirely conformable to the second edition of 1826, with an interesting introduction.

The remarkable engravings in fresh impressions. Splendid copy.

First edition of this very esteemed anatomical text-book.

Rare Italian obstetrical work, based principally on Mercurio's Comare. - Torre in "L'utero attraverso i secoli" reproduces on pp. 480 - 494 title and 5 full-page illustrations from this book. A few leaves somewhat stained, a few repairs in margins.

Two interesting letters on anatomical questions, written by the two most important anatomical investigators of the 18th century.
