The highest approved bidder shall be the purchaser, subject to the reservation that the auctioneer shall have the right (a) of regulating the amounts of the biddings; (b) of rejecting any bid; (c) of determining in his absolute discretion all disputes regarding the biddings, or any other matter arising under these conditions; and also (d) of bidding for, withdrawing, consolidating, dividing, or altering the order of any lots.

II. The lots will be sold with all faults and errors of description, and shall immediately on the fall of the hammer be at the sole risk and expense of the respective purchasers, who shall, when required, give in their names and places of business or abode, and pay down in cash a deposit of 20 per cent. of the purchase-money, or such further sum as the auctioneer may demand, and any sum so paid shall be applicable towards payment for all or any of the lots bought by such purchaser.

III. All descriptive statements contained in advertisements or catalogues, or made by the auctioneer before or at the time of sale, are to be taken as expressions of the vendor's or auctioneer's opinion, and not as warranties, and no warranty of any kind is to be implied, and it shall be assumed that the purchaser has inspected the lot he buys.

IV. The auctioneer will not recognize the transfer of any lot from one purchaser to another, nor make any alteration in the sale book in respect thereof, nor will any lot be delivered during the progress of the sale.

V. A purchaser shall not have the right to avail himself of any set-off or other plea for nonpayment of his purchase-money against the auctioneer or his principals, but he shall be liable for any unpaid purchase-money whether the lots bought have been removed or not.

VI. The auctioneer shall not be responsible for any loss occasioned by fire, accident or otherwise.

VII. VIII. Should any of the lots not be cleared within the time above specified, the purchaser shall be liable to the auctioneer for any cost of cartage, storage, or other expense occasioned by such default, and interest at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum shall be due and recoverable upon all accounts from the day of sale until the time of the settlement thereof.

IX. Any damage done to the premises, or to any other property, by the purchaser or his employees while removing his lots, or otherwise, shall be made good by the said purchaser to the satisfaction of the auctioneer.
