CONDITIONS OF SALE.

FIRST.—The highest bidder to be the purchaser, and no person shall retract a bidding; and should any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot in dispute shall be offered again or not, at the discretion of the Auctioneer, who is to be the sole arbitrator of any matter in dispute during the sale, and who also reserves the right of refusing any bidding, bidding for, buying in, and of withdrawing any lots from the sale.

SECOND.—The purchasers shall, if required, pay down the whole of the purchase-money at the time of the bidding, or, if the Auctioneer shall so decide, a deposit of Five Shillings in the Pound in part payment, and also give in their names and places of abode. The remainder of the purchase-money to be paid before any lots can be removed, which having been open to the public view, are to be taken with all imperfections, and whether or not correctly described, and whether genuine or authentic or not, and to be removed **before 4 o'clock p.m. on Monday, 4th November, 1918**, in such a way as shall be directed by the Auctioneer or his representative; but should a case arise on which an allowance is deemed necessary by the Auctioneer, he shall be at liberty either to retain the lot or make such allowance, computing the same at the rate the lot was sold for at the auction.

THIRD.—If from any cause the Auctioneer shall be unable to deliver a lot or lots, the deposit money (if any) shall be returned to the purchaser without any compensation in respect of such non-delivery.

FOURTH.—The Auctioneer reserves the right to withdraw any or part of any lot from the Catalogue prior to or at the time of the auction.

LASTLY.—Upon the failure of compliance with the above Conditions, the deposit-money shall be forfeited, and all lots remaining uncleared beyond the time limited shall be re-sold (either by public or private sale); and any deficiency, with all expenses attending such re-sale, shall be immediately made good by the defaulters at this sale.

The first part of the paper is devoted to a general
 discussion of the problem. It is shown that the

$$F(x) = \int_0^x f(t) dt + g(x)$$
 where $f(x)$ is a continuous function and $g(x)$ is a
 convex function. The minimum of $F(x)$ is attained
 at a point x^* which satisfies the equation

$$f(x^*) + g'(x^*) = 0$$
