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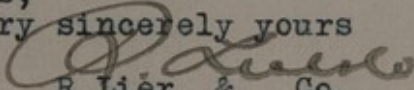

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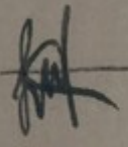

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The "Edition de la Faculté du médecine de Paris", entirely conformable to the second edition of 1826, with an interesting introduction.

Choulant-Frank, p. 315: "In response to a price question on the lymphatics, repeatedly announced by the Academy of Sciences of Paris, Mascagni sent two memoirs with illustrations; he did not receive the price. The academy, however, announced a new competition for 1789. Chiefly to insure the priority of his discoveries Mascagni published the above work in French. This contained, however, only four folio plates of the twenty-four promised for the work as planned". (Ch.-Frk).

Rare collection of dietetic writings. The treatise 'de cerevisiis' is one of the very first extensive tracts on beer and brewing. - Very nice and fresh copy of a work which is found unvariably in bad condition.

Pritzel 10764. Essling II, 1194. - Rare first edition of the Herbarius Latinus translated into Italian. The work is divided into seven parts: the first part dealing with the description of 150 plants, illustrated by the same number of woodcuts; the remaining six parts, occupying together 96 chapters, discuss the same number of drugs. The Herbolario volgare is a close translation of the Herbarius Latinus with a preface by the translator, and an index of diseases with their remedies, in alphabetic order. "The Herbarium has an important place in the history of botany and medicine, because of its age and its wide distribution". It gives us an exact knowledge of popular medicine and medical botany of its time. The woodcuts, being still crude, are nevertheless of a certain artistic and historical value as the earliest attempts to design plants. - Copies of this rare first Italian edition are mostly incomplete. Our complete copy is in fine condition with uncoloured woodcuts. Only an insignificant hole on title-leaf mended, with loss of a couple of letters (on verso only). Rare !!

Roederer, at the instigation of Haller, was appointed to the University of Goettingen as the first professor of obstetrics in Germany. "The first German institution for the instruction of male obstetricians was founded under Roederer at Goettingen in 1751" (Garrison).
