- 4 What the fines are or may be Reputed to be worth  
certaine annys,
- 5 What Landes and Woods or Lands held Servit<sup>e</sup> or Commendam  
belonging to each Hospital and who hath y<sup>e</sup> Letting and Rettynge  
of the same,
- 6 Who are Officers in trust (if any such be) for y<sup>e</sup> said Hospitals  
and whether you have heard any just Complaint against  
them that they have not performed their trust,
- 7 Who is y<sup>e</sup> present Master Warden Prior Governeur or  
of one of the said Hospitals. And what is his Allowance  
according to the foundation or what is his place Reputed  
to be worth in common Estime,
- 8 How many poor are maintained in each Hospital  
of what sort Men Women or Children, And what their  
Places are worth according to the foundation or  
Reputed according to the common Estime, and whether  
there be now as many Members as ought to be  
by y<sup>e</sup> foundation, if not, how many and what places  
are ready. And who receives the Profite of them  
And if they all have their Allowances duly  
made them as they ought,
- 9 What Statutes Orders or Rules y<sup>e</sup> said Hospitals respectively  
are governed by and to send yo<sup>e</sup> copies of them
