These are to signify to whom it may concerne, & in behalfe of Mr William Randolph of St. Johns Colledge in Cambridge Master of Arts & Student in Physick, that to my knowledge having elapsed the yeare due to his being graued with degree of M^r. of Arts therupon those troubles & onsettements as well in University as generally prewailing, that on the returne of his Majestie Anno 1660. he did imediately returne & was with all accustomed formes invested with his degree of Master in order to proceed in time Doctor in the same faculty, This is testified by me at the same Comencement going out M^r. of Arts with Mr. Randolph. witness my hand
