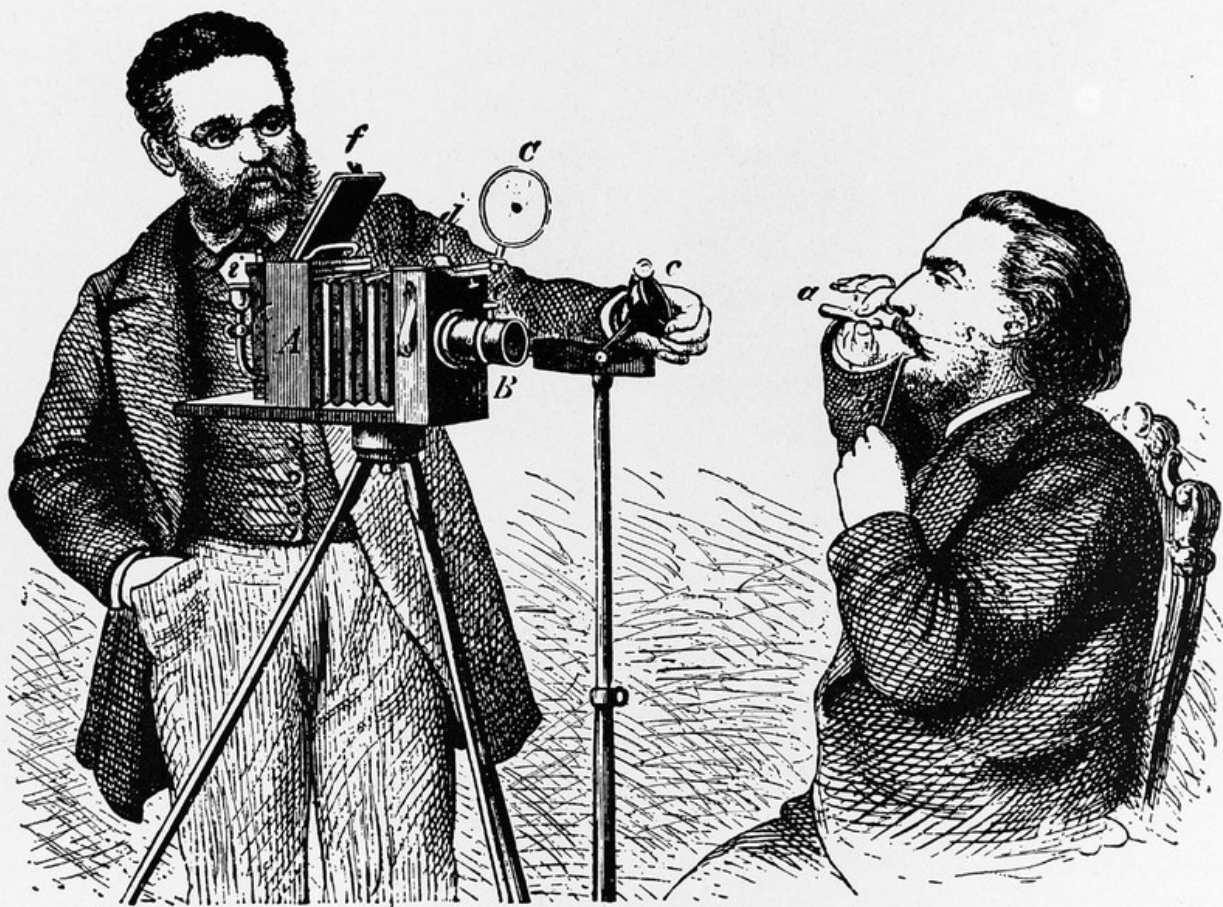


FIG. 7. EARLY METHOD OF PHOTOGRAPHING THE LARYNX.
