#### GREEK FUNERARY MONUMENT

Inscribed to Jason, also called Deimos the Achaean, a Physician.

It shows him palpating the liver of a patient with swollen abdomen and wasted limbs. The ridge caused by the enlarged liver is clearly indicated. On the right is a large cupping vessel.
