Having had occasion in some
late communications to you, to speak
of the District which has been deci-
ded on (under a law of Congress) for
the permanent ^{seat} of the government of
the United States, I do myself the plea-
sure of sending you a plan of the
intended City, which is now laying
out in the centre thereof. —

such as may have the curiosity to
look at it, that whatever our pre-
sent condition is, we have vanity
enough to look forward to a better
