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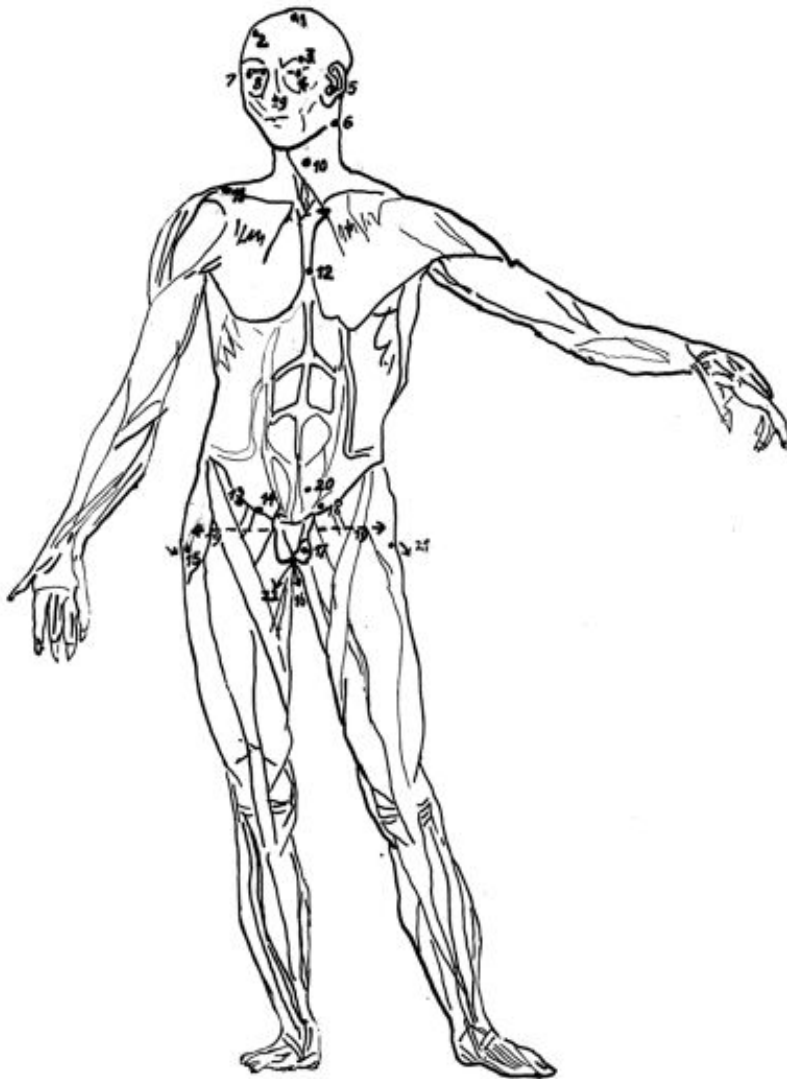

PATHOLOGICAL CONDITIONS KNOWN TO THE THE ANCIENT EGYPTIANS WERE IDENTICAL WITH THOSE CURRENT AMONG MODERN FELLAHIN. THEY INCLUDED OPHTHALMIA, SKIN-DISEASES, BILHARZIA INFECTION AND INTESTINAL COMPLAINTS.

IN THE MEDICAL POPYRI, EACH CONDITION IS DULY DIAGNOSED, A VERDICT STATED AND A TREATMENT PRESCRIBED. THIS LAST IS USUALLY PHARMACEUTICAL IN CHARACTER.

IN ADDITION TO LITERARY EVIDENCE, MUCH KNOWLEDGE OF ANCIENT EGYPTIAN PATHOLOGY HAS BEEN DERIVED FROM THE SYSTEMATIC EXAMINATION OF MUMMIES.
