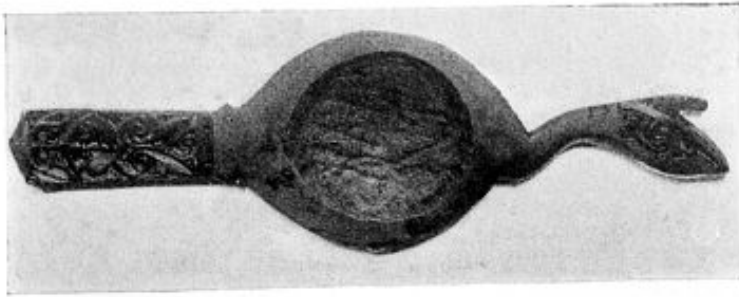

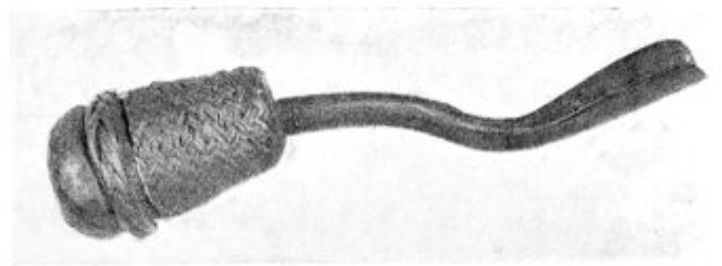

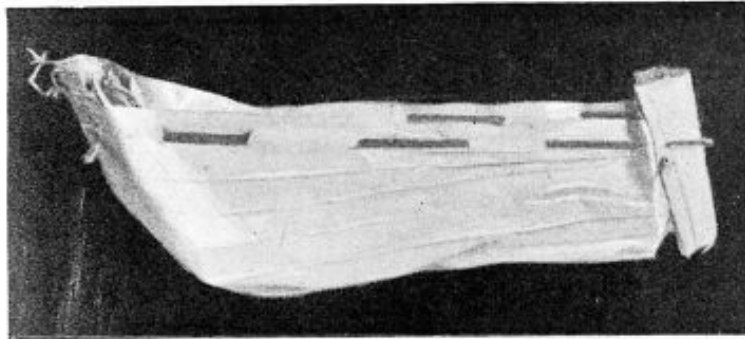

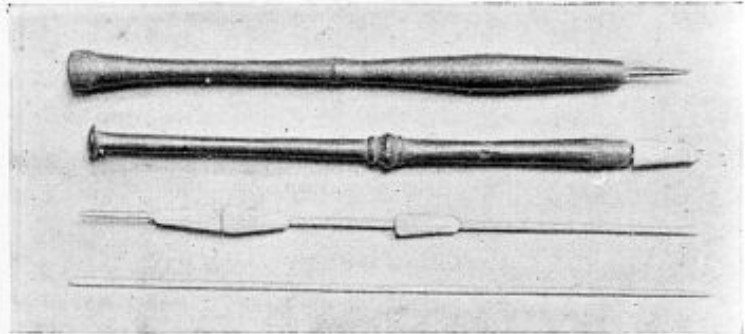
5. WOODEN PALETTE FOR MIXING POISON.
