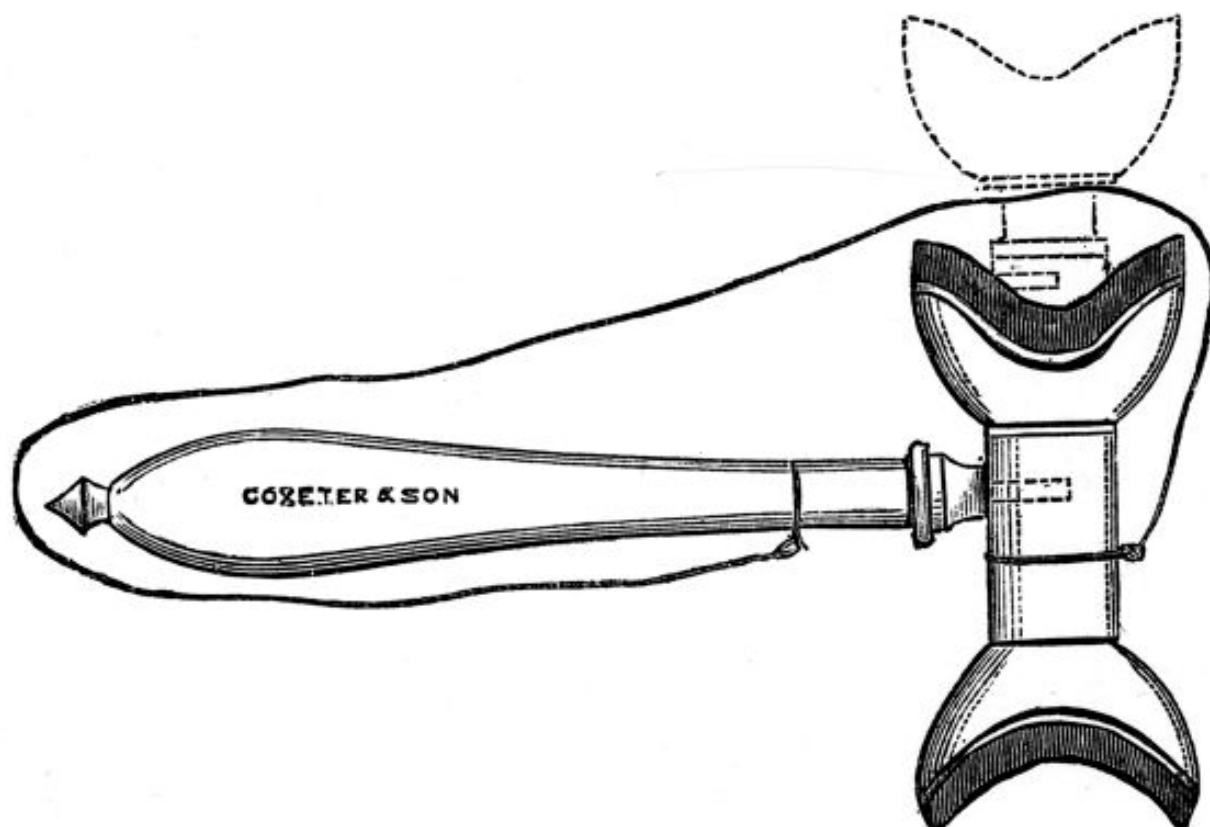

MACADAM'S improved mouth-props, set of three (*Fig. 227*) 0 18 0

These mouth-props are made of vulcanite, with soft india-rubber pads for the teeth, and springs (as CLOVER'S) to prevent their falling out of the mouth while using; the handle is employed for placing the prop in the mouth.

Red india-rubber gasometer tubing, $\frac{7}{8}$ -in. ... per foot 0 2 0

Gasometer, 15-gallon, with screw unions, complete, for liquid gas-vessel and large tubing 5 0 0

Wash-leather covers for face-pieces of sizes per doz. 0 3 0

Indianette bag, holding 36 gallons, with wood mounts ... 1 10 0

Empty vessels for liquid gas can be exchanged for filled ones at the rate of 3d. per gallon.
