Bertrams 10 Sept 1840

The terms are accepted, & I promise that you shall
have one quarter part of the neat profit arising
from my inoculation with the skin for the
space of 12 months, provided it be not made
public before that term expires - & then the
contract shall remain in full force only to the time
of its becoming public: however on your
part it is expected, that the like privilege
will not be granted to others in my vicinity.
