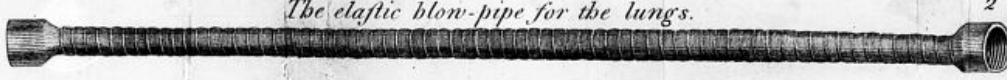

The elastic blow-pipe for the lungs.



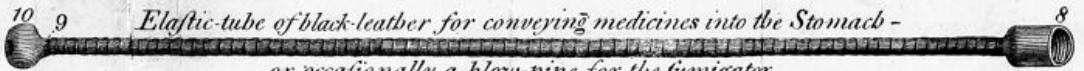
The mouth piece of the elastic -

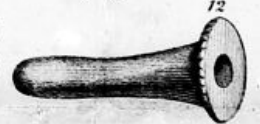
Winch for the screm.



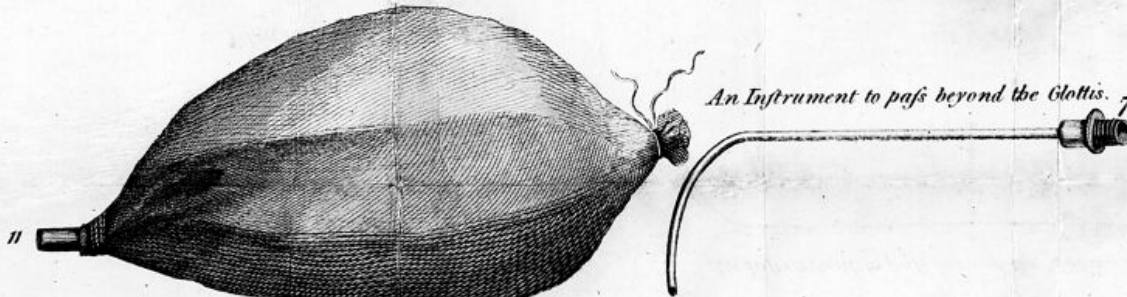
The hollow connecting screm.
