AD umbilicum fere perducta est opella nostra. Explicatae partes corporis cunctæ, quæ in oculos incurunt, suaq; singulis proportio addita. Super est, ut more Rhetoribus usitato, in summam colligentes quæ dicta sunt, ex omnibus membris inter se conjunctis integrum formemus hominem. Id quod ut commodius fiat, in medium prius afferemus catalogum, qui secundum tres dimensiones corporis, omnium partium symmetriam contineat. Et quoniam partes corporis humani pleræq; teretes sunt, adeoq; profunditas cum latitudine coincidit, aut ex peripheriæ diametro facile colligitur: ideoque facta substitutione, has dimensionum species modo proponemus, Longitudinē, Latitudinem, Circumferentiā.
