



Dr. Quain's stethometer (Figs. 209, 210, and 211), an instrument designed for measuring the mobility of the walls of the chest, consists of a cord connected by an axle with an index, which it is capable of moving over a graduated dial. The cord being extended from a fixed point on the chest to another, the extent of the respiratory movement will be manifested by the tension made on the cord being communicated to the index and shown in figures on the dial, from which it can be read off in fractions of an inch.
