Trichotomex	1 ditto.
Nervousness, and Laceration	1 by chronic treatment.*
Joint inflammation of 25	1 by one truss.
Spondylic Colla	1 by repeated trusses in 24
Acute inflammation of the eye	5 hours.
Chronic ditto	1 by chronic treatment.
Acute inflammation of testis	1 by repeated trusses in 20
Cervical ditto	1 by one truss.
Laceration from Rheumatism	2 by chronic treatment.
Lumbago	1 by ground and laid new- moulding for a week.
Scleritis	1 ditto.
Pain in cranial nerve	1 ditto.
Pain of ear-nerve	1 ditto for a month.
Ditto of half the body	1 ditto for 6 weeks.
Falling of breast, swelling near the body	1 by one truss.

It will be perceived that the above cases are chiefly dis-
eases of the nervous system. But as sleep and the absence
of pain is the best condition of the body for promoting the
resolution of inflammation by the powers of Nature, I have
extricated local inflammations by keeping the patients
tranquil till this was effected.

* By chronic treatment is meant daily reuniting without
the intention of extending the patient, which is not necessary.
