### Explanation of the Figures.

Fig. 1. A vertical section of the ox's eye, of twice the natural size:

A. The cornea, covered by the tunica conjunctiva.

BCB. The sclerotica, covered at BB by the tunica albuginea, and tunica conjunctiva.

DD. The choroid, consisting of two laminas.

EE. The circle of adherence of the choroid and sclerotica.

FG. FG. The orbiculus ciliaris.

HI, HK. The uvea; its anterior surface the iris; its posterior surface lined with pigmentum nigrum.

IK. The pupil.

HL, HL. The ciliary processes, covered with pigmentum nigrum.

MM. The retina.

N. The aqueous humour.

O. The crystalline lens.

P. The vitreous humour.

QR, QR. The zona ciliaris.

RS, RS. The annulus mucosus.
