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
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# By the King, A PROCLAMATION,

Commanding Apothecaries to follow the Dispensatory lately compiled by the College of Physicians of London.

hereas nothing is more likely to be of Fatal Confequence to the healths and Lives of Our Subjects, than the ill Compounding or Paking up of Pedicines, to be Administred to Persons assisted with Sickness, contrary to the Prescriptions of their Physicians, besides that a gross Deceit thereby would be put upon the Patients: And whereas there has been compiled, in the Latin Tongue, by the College of Physicians of London, a Book Intituled, Pharmacopoxia Londinensis, prescribing and directing Apothecaries the General Forms of Dispensing and Compounding all Sorts of Accidences, Distilling Oyls and Waters, and making such like Extracts, together with the true Weights and Weafures, by which they ought to be made; which Book, through the great Care and Industry of the said College, has been lately Repised

tend to the Publick Good of Dur Subjens, by preventing all Deceits, Differences, Clarieties, and Incertainties in Making of Compounding of the Dedicines, and Diffilling of the Dyls of Maters therein mentioned, if, for the future, the Manner and Form preferibed by the faid Book Gould be generally and folely practifed by Apothecaries, and others, in their Compositions of the faid Deditines, and Distillations of the faid Waters or Dyls, &c. The therefore being desirous to provide in all Cafes for the Common Good of Dur People, and being perswaded the Chablishing the General Ale of the faid 2600k may tend to the Prevention of such Deceits in the Waking and Compounding Medicines, Wherein the Lives and healths of Our Subjects are to highly concerned, have, by and with the Advice of Dur Priby-Council, thought fit to Idue this Dur Royal Proclamation, Rotify= ing to all Apothecaries and others concerned, to the Intent they may not pretend Ignorance thereof, that the faid 2800k, called Pharmacopæia Londinensis is perfected, and ready to be Published. And case therefore arialy Require, Charge, and Command all and lingular Apothecaries and others, whose Bulinelsitis to compound Dedicines of diffilled Dyls of Maters, of make other Extracts within any part of Dur Kingdom of Great Britain called England, Dominion of Wales, oz Town of Berwick upon Tweed, that they and every of them, immediately after the faid Pharmacopæia Londinensis shall be printed and publifhed, do not compound, or make any Dedicine or Dedicineable Receipt or Prefcription, or biffit any Dyl of Waters, of make other Ertrans, that are of thall be in the faid Pharmacopoeia Londinensis mentioned or named, in any other manner or form than is or hall be directed, preferibed, and fet down by the faid Book, and according to the Weights and Deafures that are or hall be therein li= mited, ercept it hall be by the Special Direction or Prescription of some Learned Physician in that behalf. And the do hereby Publish and Declare that the Offenders to the Contrary shall not only incur Dur just Displeasure, but be proceeded against for such their Contempt and Offences, according to the utmost Severities of Law.
