PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

ASSEMBLING.

Cars assemble at 1.40 p.m. The rendezvous is the Royal Cripples Hospital at the corner of Sheepcote Street and Broad Street, Birmingham. **All (except Nos. 61—120) will enter from Broad Street into Oozells Street**, to take up their positions.

Nos. 61—100 will enter **Cumberland Street** at the Broad Street end.

Cars will be parked as follows:—

Marshal: Mr. D. THOMAS.

Nos. 1—40: R.H. side of Sheepcote Street facing Broad Street.

Marshal: Mr. W. BISHOP.

Nos. 41—60: L.H. side of Oozells Street North, facing Sheepcote Street.

Marshal: Mr. T. EGERTON.

Nos. 61—90: L.H. side of Cumberland Street.

Marshal: Mr. E. H. TWIBELL.

Nos. 91—120: R.H. side of Cumberland Street.

Marshal: Mr. F. WATSON.

Nos. 121—150: R.H. side of Oozells Street North, facing Sheepcote Street.

Marshal: Mr. A. MURRAY.

Nos. 151—180: L.H. side of Oozells Street, facing Oozells Street, North.

Marshal: Mr. P. W. MOSLEY WHITE.

Nos. 181—220: R.H. side of Oozells Street, facing Oozells Street, North.

Marshals' cars will be parked on L.H. side of Sheepcote Street, facing Broad Street. Reserve Cars follow them.

Positions of leading cars (Nos. 1, 41, 61, 91, 121, 151, 181) will be indicated by numbered cards (Mr. H. J. GITTINGS in charge). Others take up proper numerical sequence. In every case cars must be parked close to the kerb so that the centre of the road may be kept free for traffic.

Will Marshals please see that cars arriving early leave sufficient room for intermediate cars to get into position?

Any cars not in position at 1.55 p.m. to be reported to Mr. Ray. As Marshals pass their cars into the next section they will please enquire for further duty.

DEPARTURE.

Children will be received by Marshals (Messrs. H. J. Gittings, T. W. Gittins, W. J. Kelly, Gilbert Bird, and F. V. Ranger) and conducted to the respective cars.

Cars will load in groups of five, and each group must load and depart in 1 min. 20 secs. Cars should come regularly and punctually into position. Girls holding cards with Nos. will indicate where each Car must pull up.

Be ready to respond promptly to the signal to start.

Cars turn left into Broad Street, and proceed to Edward Street. **Several sharp turns, but watch police signals and you will make no mistake.** There they will be mustered into sections of 20 (Marshals, Mr. H. E. Jefferiss, Mr. F. W. Ehret and Mr. Gilbert Brookes) and then despatched.

ROUTE MARKING.

Mr. A. S. Coleman, will mark the route with arrows and will also control the parking of Cars upon arrival at destination.

R.A.C. Guides will be posted along the route and at destination, while the repair Car will render help in case of necessity.

Cars will unload in front of large hut at foot of field. Children go directly into hut for tea. (In case of rain this instruction may be altered; Mr. A. S. Coleman would then advise).
