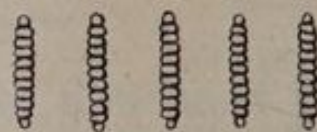

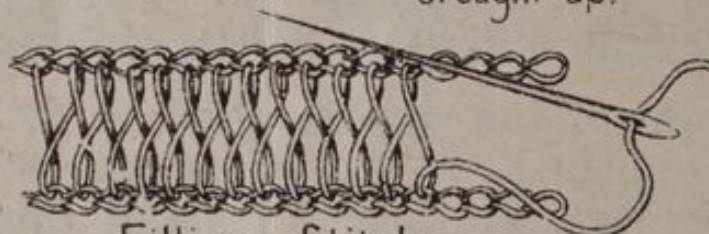
Double Herringbone Stitch

Is best worked in two colours, first one, then the other & from left to right. Inset needle horizontally from right & make stitch, bring thread down to right, make another, bringing needle out under where the last went in, the 2nd thread is worked over where the other crosses.



Coil or Bullion Stitch

Bring needle up and full length of thread, winding the thread several times round the needle, and inserting it about a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch below where it was brought up.



Filling Stitch

Is very simple & effective. Stitch (see Chain Stitch Herringbone worked the inner loop of best to rule two

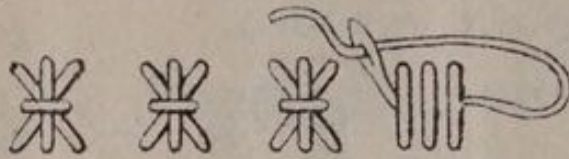

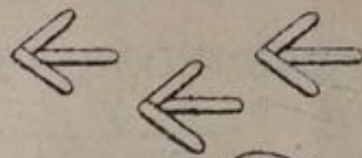

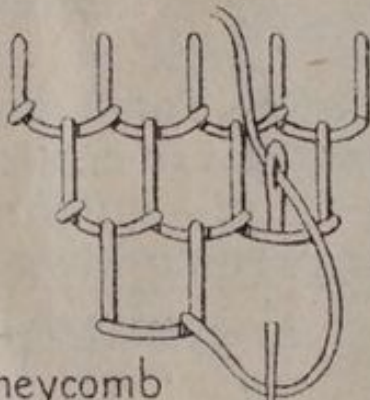
Cluster Stitch.

Draw out your design first. Make the stitches $\frac{1}{4}$ inch long, group three together, then with another coloured thread tie them through the centre (see illustration).



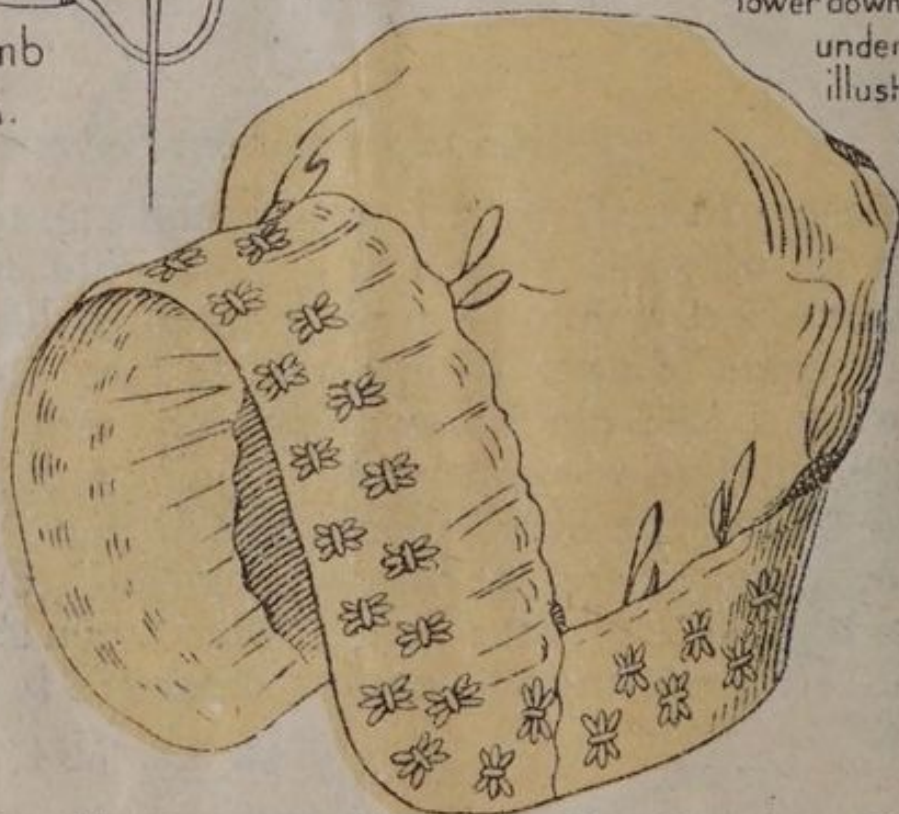
Arrowhead Stitch.

This stitch should be worked with the arrow pointing to the left, and is merely three stitches all meeting at the arrow point, with the centre stitch a little longer than the other two.



Honeycomb Stitch.

Begin on left. A series of loosely worked buttonhole stitches are worked, then worked back from right to left. All stitches should be equal in length, the needle passing behind the loop of previous row, & out a little lower down with thread under needle, illustration clearly shows.



Child's Bonnet worked with Cluster Stitch

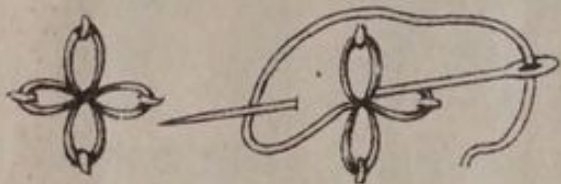

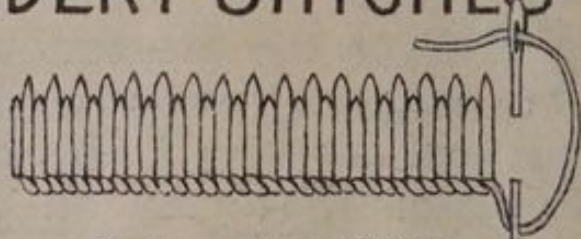

Tied Loop Stitch.

All stitches are marked from the centre, insert needle, make a loop & tie it down with a small stitch. this makes a pretty background if work is regular



Button-Hole Stitch.

If you look at the illustration it can easily be seen how it is worked, one long and one short stitch, the thread always going under the needle, it is mostly used for bordering purposes.



French Knots.

Bring up needle and thread to full length, twist thread round the needle 3 or 4 times and insert needle close to where it came up, as illustration clearly shows.

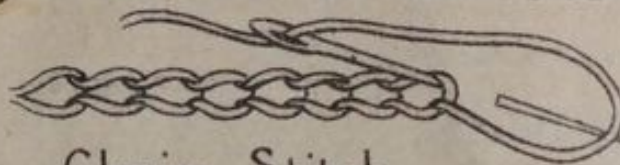


Baby's Bib worked with Button-hole Stitch & Tied Loop Stitch.

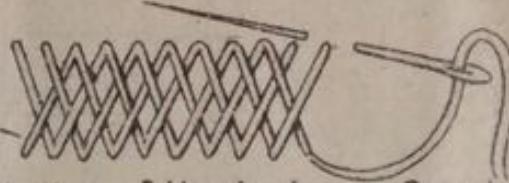

Chain Stitch.

Is a simple stitch composed of a series of loops the thread coming out of each loop, inserting the needle at side of each, with the thread under the needle.



Variation of Herringbone Stitch.

Is worked from left to right in the same way as Herringbone stitch, but closer together, as illustration.



Fishbone Stitch.

Is similar to Coral Stitch much longer, the illustration is done.

Pin Cushion worked with Chain Stitch.

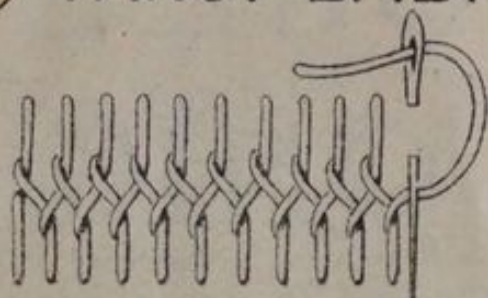

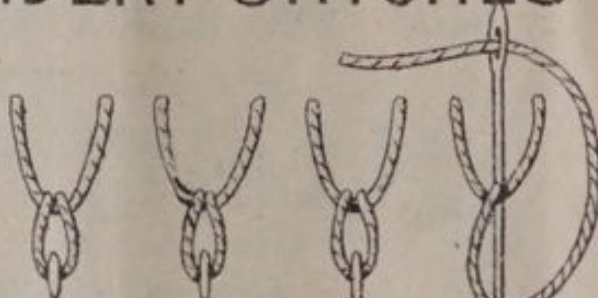
FANCY EMBROIDERY STITCHES



Double Buttonhole Stitch.

Draw two parallel lines, bring needle and thread in centre of the lines & make buttonhole stitch by putting needle in at upper line, & out again, just above where it was first brought out, draw stitch through. Now put needle through lower line, pass it up a little below where it started, a little to the right, draw stitch through and make next stitch from the top line.

You first work from top line, then from bottom.



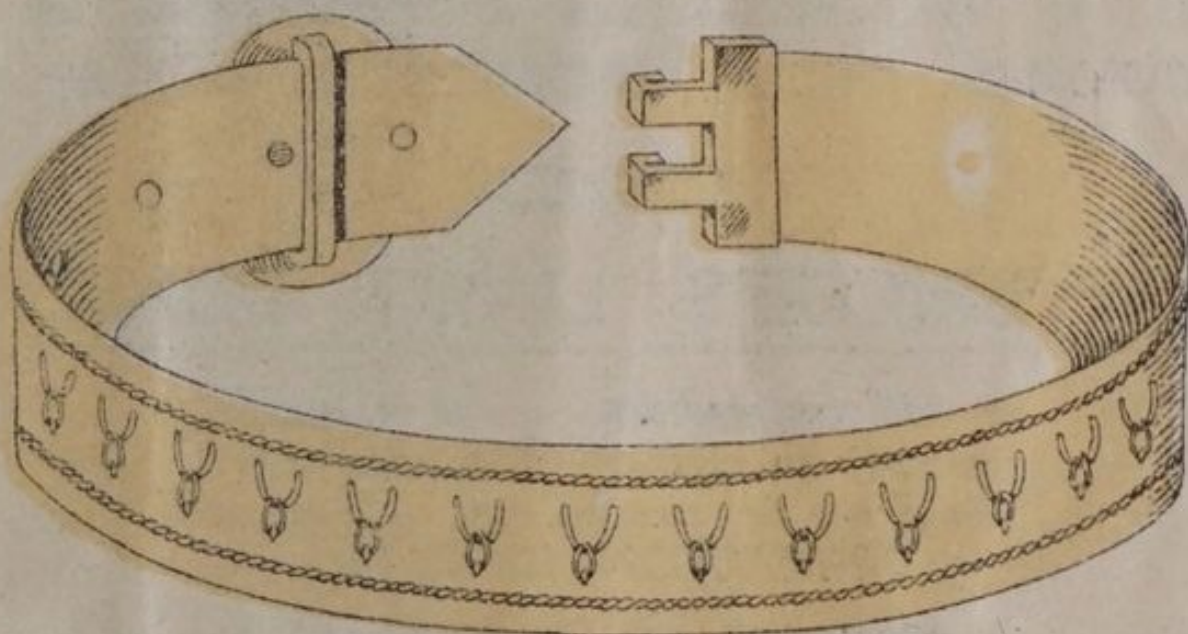
Tête de Boeuf Stitch.

First make a loop, then at end of loop bring out the needle & insert it close to the same spot, making a smaller loop which is tied with a small stitch.



Padded Rope Stitch.

This stitch is useful for outlining. Run a length of coarse thread making large stitches on right side of material & short ones on underside, so as to get as little break as possible between the runnings. Then work over same with stem stitch (illustration explains).

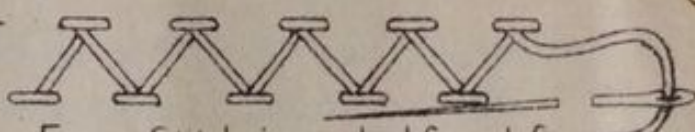

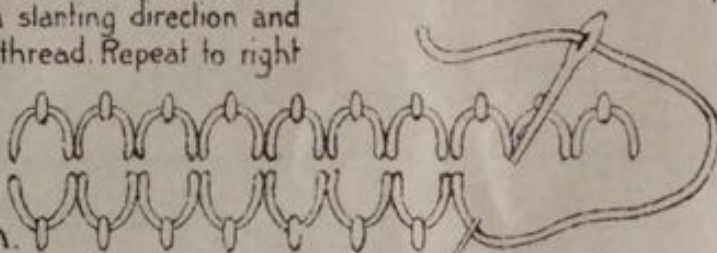


Double Coral Stitch. Care should be taken to keep work a uniform width, rule three lines, bring the thread up in centre, form into loop, hold loop down with left thumb, insert needle making another loop on left, a short distance from where the needle came up, bringing it out in a slanting direction and over the held down thread. Repeat to right and left, this is worked perpendicularly.



Fancy Stitch is worked from left to right and makes a very pretty design if worked in rows. This stitch can easily be copied from the illustration.

Open Loop Stitch.



It is always as well to draw lines to ensure keeping work even and straight. This is worked from left to right. Make the loop, then the stitch which holds the loop, when row is completed, reverse and work same underneath.
