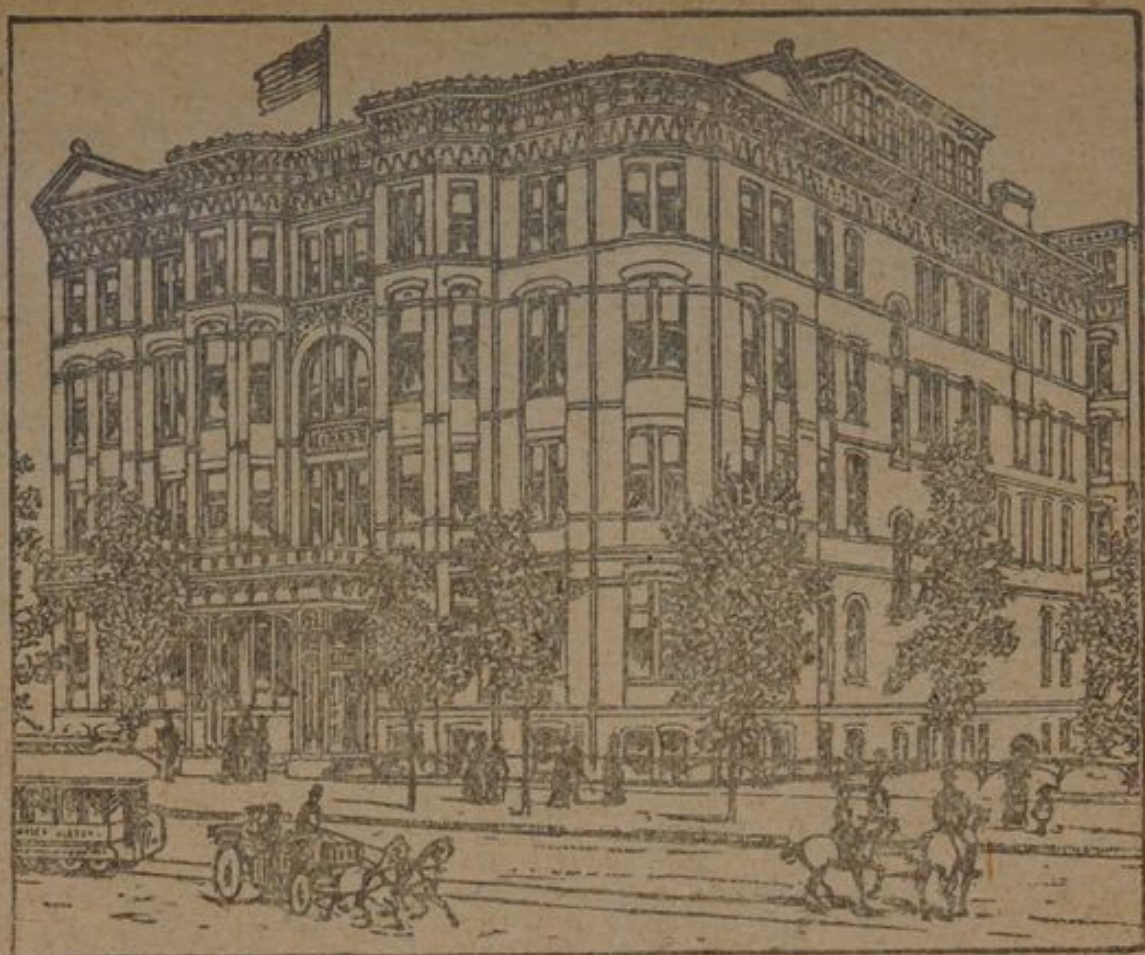

THE BASIS OF LIFE.

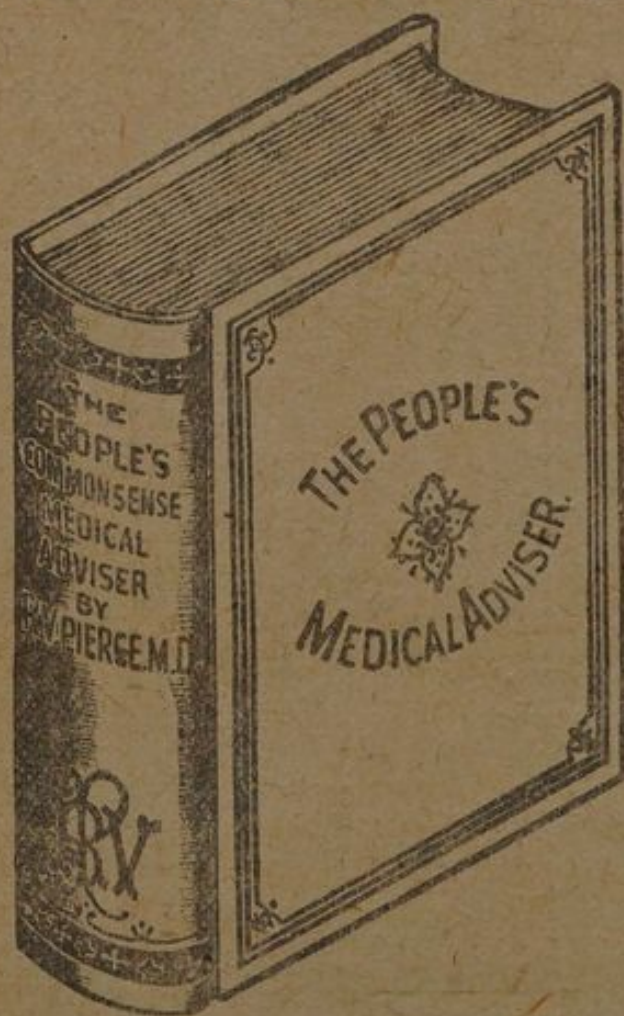
