The sayd Clyslay Kempe had fourte syrites vij. their names Tetter a hee like a gray Cat, Jack a hee like a black Cat: Pygma the, like a
Jack Toad, & Trysyn a hee, like a white Lambe. The hees were to plague to death, & the shees to punish with bodily harme, & to destroy cauess

Trysyn Clyslays white spirit did tell her alwayes (when she asked) what the other witches had done: And by her the most part were appelle
id, which spirit told her alwayes true. As is well approued by the other Witches confession.

The sayd Ales Newman had the sayd Clyslay Kempe spirits to vise at her pleasure.

Elizabeth Bennet had two spirits vij. their names Buckyn, a hee like a blacke Dog: And Lyard reylige & Lyon or Hare.

Ales Hunt had two spirits lyke Colies, the one blacke, the other white.

11 Margery Banmon had two spirits like Toads, their names Tom and Robyn.

Clyslay Celles had two spirits by severall names vij. Sotheons Hercules, Jack o' Mercury.

Ales Mansfield and Margaret Greuell had in common by agreement iii. sp[irit]s, v. their names Robin, Jack, Will, Pupper, alias Sp[irit]s
mer, wherof two were heez, and two shees, lyke vmo black Corgs.

Elizabeth Twstace had iii. Impes or sp[irit]s, of colour white, grey and black.

Anny's Herd had vi. Impes or sp[irit]s like awles and black bydes, And vi. otherlike hinde, of the bygnes of Rato, with short boynes, the
Gules shre fed with wheat, barley, Otes and bread, the hinde with strew and hey.
