

M0014147: Autograph letter from Baron Thomas Dimsdale, dated 27 June 1777

The sincere disposition I feel to give every possible assistance to her Majesty's service & the full confidence I have in your honor & good principles will not suffer me to remain a moment in suspense about supplying you with the Money you have occasion for; I therefore enclose a Draught for the sum of £250 payable ten Days after sight & shall be very easy about taking a proper acknowledgement when I can have the pleasure of seeing you.
