OBERCASSEL MAN

One of the Obercassel skeletons bears the mark of an old injury on the left parietal bone. The right ulna was fractured. There is evidence of general arthritis deformans.

A fistula of the lower jaw and remains of purulent inflammation of the periodontal membrane of a right molar are revealed.
