The Royal PROCESSION of QUEEN ELIZABETH to Visit the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> HENRY CAREY Lord HUNSDON,  
Governor of Berwick upon Tweed, Captain of the Band of Gentlemen Pensioners R<sup>e</sup> of the most Noble Order of the Garter,  
Privy Councillor and Cousin Germain to her Majestie by the Lady MARY, Sister to QUEEN ANNA BOLEN.

The Original of that Picture was painted (in Oyl) at the command of his Heire Lord Hunsdon (cir 1585) and is now in the possession of the R<sup>th</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Digby,  
who permitted a Limning to be taken in Water Colours, for the R<sup>th</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> Edward Earl of Oxford & Mortimer, and this Plate to be Engraved by  
their most humble and obteinent Servt Ge. Vertue 1742.

Sword of State before the Queen.  
William Lord Burleigh Lord High  
Treasurer with his White Staff  
before him is Charles Howard
