

M0015292: Illustration of how a spear is thrown by people in the circumpolar region and Australia

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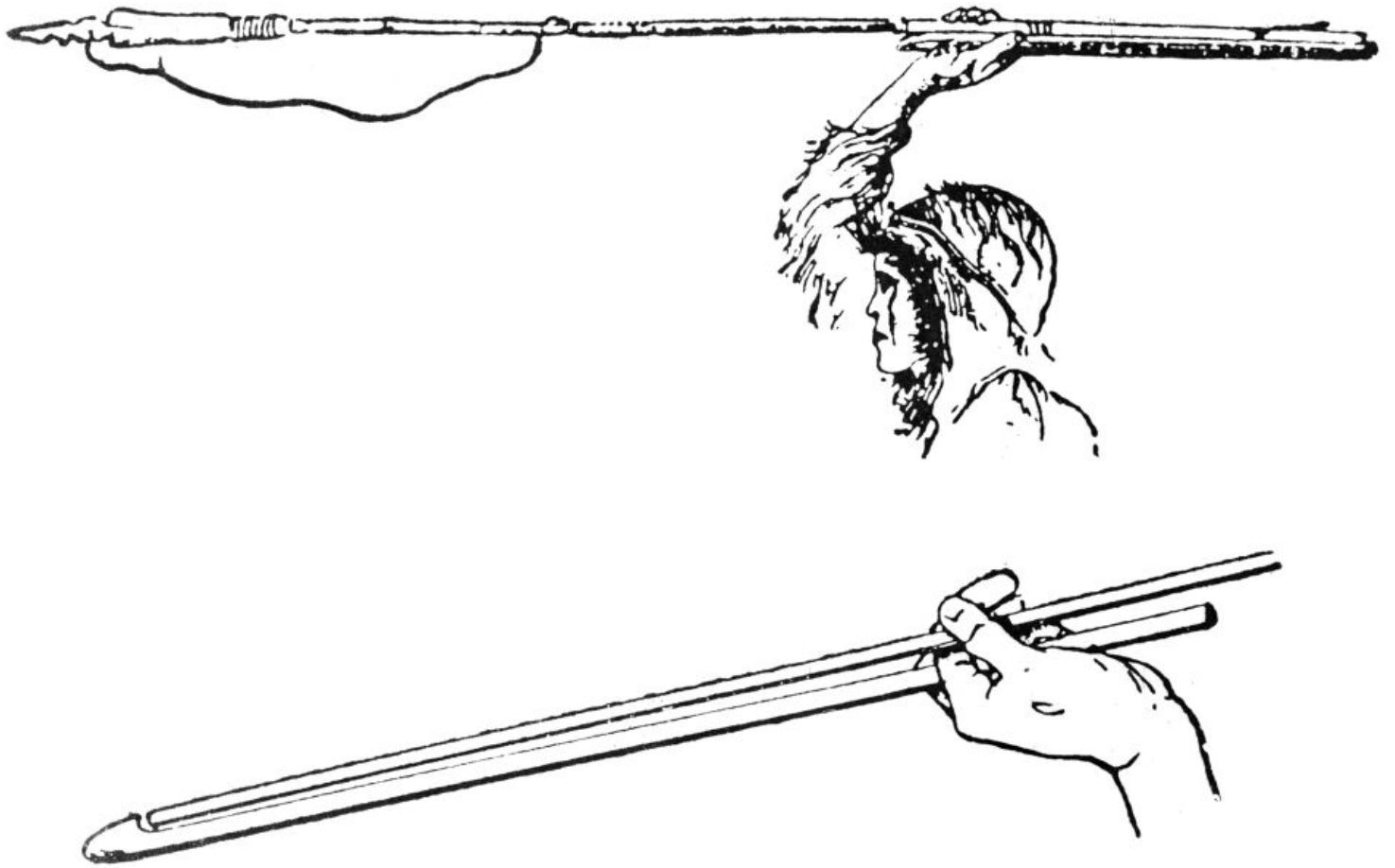
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The upper figure shows how the spear-thrower is used by the Eskimo, the lower one by the Australian.
