# KRAPINA MAN

Of the five hundred fragments of human bones examined at Krapina, some, notably one lower jaw, show evidences of arthritis deformans. The process at the articulation of the mandible may have been an infective arthritis, since a fistula is described as occuring below the joint and apparently pyorrhoea also: an ulna, two patellae, and some vertebrae show what is probably arthritis deformans.

There is also a clavicle showing a well united fracture.
