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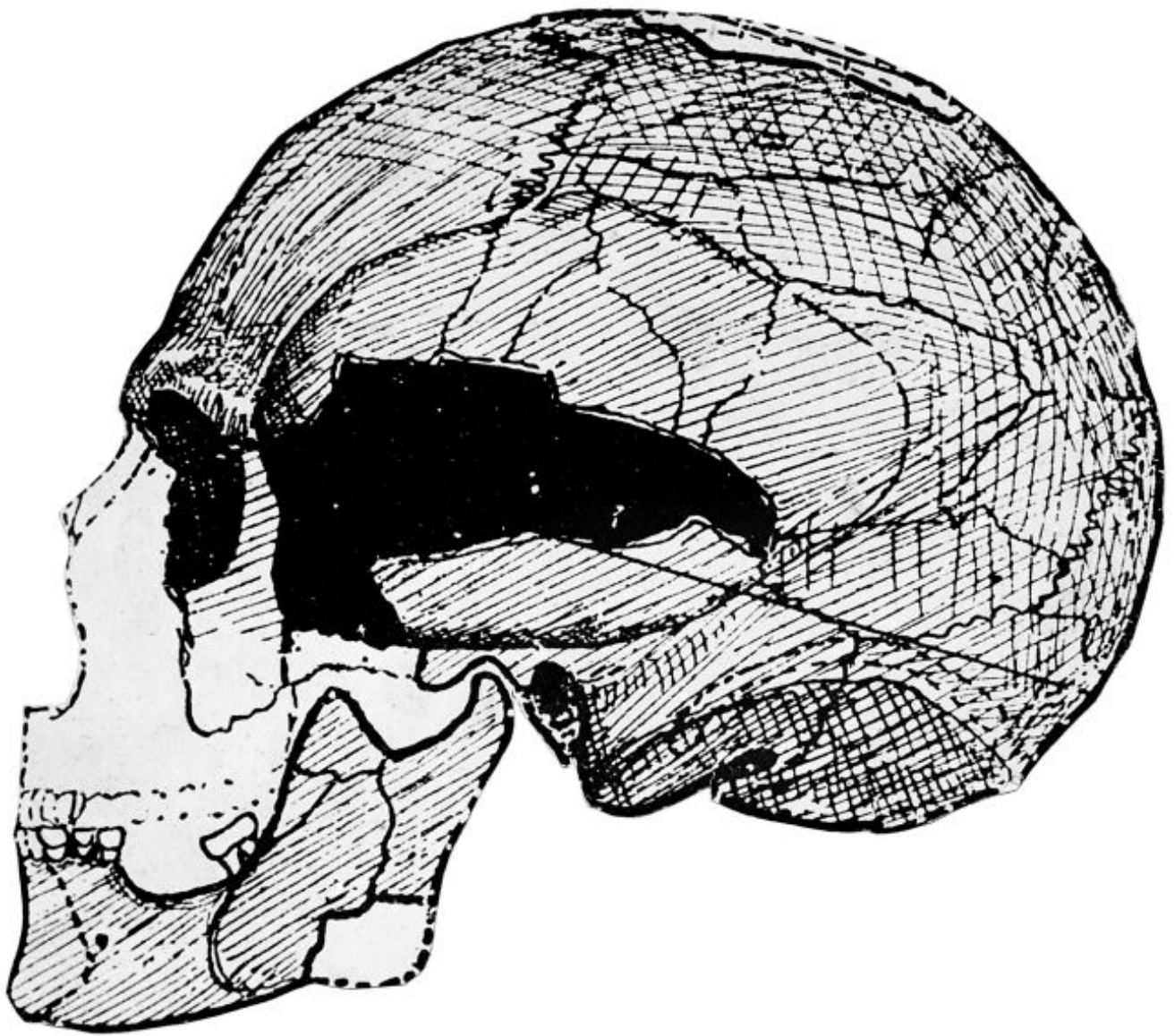
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HALLING MAN

Halling man is estimated to have been about forty years old at his death. The teeth showed decided evidences of attrition. Five of the molars had been lost from disease (abscesses), and one of the premolars had been likewise lost before death.
