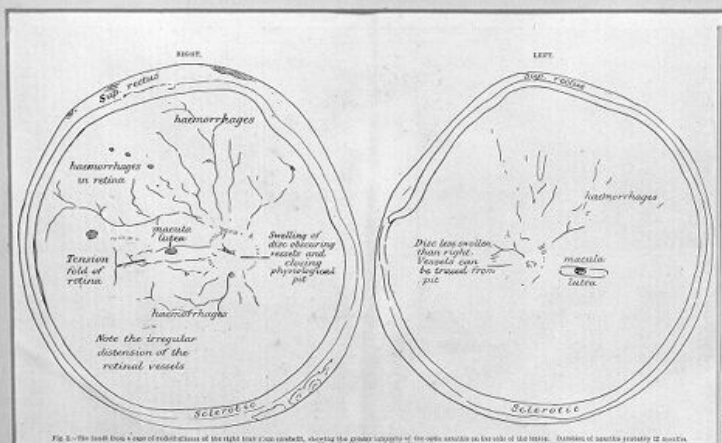


Fig. 1.—The fundus of the right eye (normal), showing the normal support of the optic nerve on the side of the base. Position of papilla probably 12 months.

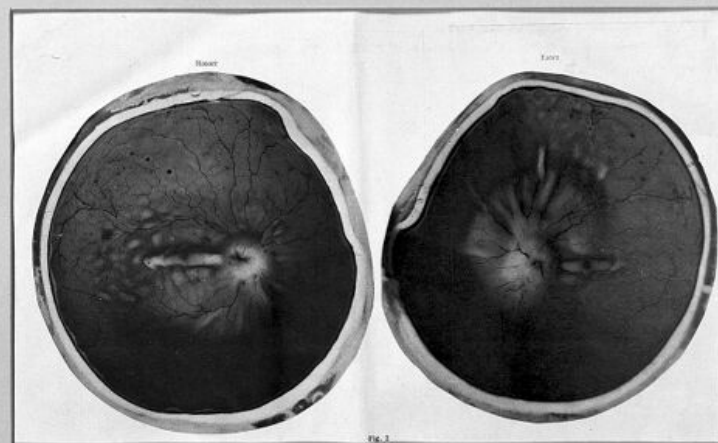
