




PAVLOV (Russian, 1849–1936)

Conditional reflexes. Evolutionary analysis of cortical function. Reciprocal excitation and inhibition. Combination of comparative psychology with nerve physiology.



RAMON Y CAJAL (Spanish, 1852–1934)

Termination of nerve fibers in gray matter. Anatomic, functional, trophic and reactional unity and independence of the neuron. Polarization of the various nerve impulses.



KRAEPELIN (German, 1856–1926)

Psychiatric nosology. Systematization of clinical psychiatry. Clinical classification of mental disease. Differentiation between endogenous and exogenous psychoses.
