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SEPTEMBER

9th Month

1894

Ivoo

3 MONDAY [246-119]

A glorious day. Arthur, Bolla & Julie had a grand expedition to the top of the chief mountain here (Kvamshesten) 4000 feet high exactly as shown by the pocket aneroid. They had one of our landlady, Mrs. Daa's, servant girls for their guide, who acquainted with the mountain & delighted to be allowed to go. They started at 11.30 & got back about 8.

Some nice alpine plants got by them.

I took my fishing rod & the unimpaired stream that flows into the fjord just below Ivoo, but with no success.

4 TUESDAY [247-118]

Another glorious day.

After midday meal we went in the fjord in boats, one taking Bolla & Julie, Mr. Daa (our landlady's sister) & two girls (best friend from beyond Föride) & the a servant girl, who waits at table to row; the other taking Arthur & me, Arthur rowing.

The other party landed on the right side from here & walked to the foss where Bolla sketched, while the rest took a stroll in the valley above. Arthur & I went to the foss & saw the salmon ladder there & took a gentle walk along a level road in the Ivoo direction & back. Julie joined our boat home.
